### ORDER:

The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India has released a Cyber Crisis Management Plan (CCMP) for Countering Cyber Attacks and Cyber Terrorism. The CCMP outlines a framework for dealing with cyber related incidents for a co-ordinated, multi-disciplinary and broad-based approach for rapid identification, information, exchange, swift response and remedial actions to mitigate and recover from malicious cyber related incidents impacting critical national processes.

2. Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (CDAC), is a premier organization under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) for carrying out Research and Development (R&D) in IT, Electronics and associated areas. In the recent years, increased Internet penetration has given exponential rise in sophisticated attacks on Information Technology (IT) infrastructure. Attackers are gaining access to sensitive information. In this scenario, CDAC is focusing on the Security Domain on adaptive Intrusion Detection using advanced concepts in Artificial Intelligence and Data Mining to enable the Intrusion Detection Systems to learn new attack patterns by continuously analyzing the network traffic and deducing the behavior.

3. In the letter 1<sup>st</sup> read above, the Managing Director, ELCOT has requested for

- (i) Administrative approval to implement the Cyber Security Architecture for Tamil Nadu (CSA-TN) at an estimated cost of Rs.21.39 Crores with 3 year Operations and Management for 50 Government Departments and
- (ii) Approval for the Detailed Project Report (DPR) for implementation of Cyber Security Architecture for Tamil Nadu (CSA-TN).

4. The Hon'ble Chief Minister has also announced on the floor of the State Legislative Assembly, under Rule 110 of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rules, on 1.6.2018 that Cyber Security Architecture for Tamil Nadu (CSA-TN) will be implemented through ELCOT at a cost of Rs.21.39 crore.

5. In the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Managing Director, ELCOT, has proposed the following :-

- i. The procurement activities and the Security Domain Specialized Services are to be bifurcated
- ii. Procurement of products will be taken up by the ELCOT Procurement Wing. CDAC will provide necessary specification, certification for the products and evaluation of the products on security aspects
- iii. All the Procurement and Security Domain Specialized Services other than the product procurement are to be executed by CDAC, by way of signing MoU with ELCOT

6. The Government after careful examination of the above, hereby

- (a) Grant administrative approval to ELCOT for implementing the Cyber Security Architecture for Tamil Nadu (CSA-TN) at an estimated cost of Rs.21.39 Crores with three years Operations and Management for 50 Government Departments.
- (b) Exempt ELCOT under Section 16 (bb) of the TNTIT Act for availing specialized services worth of Rs.9.49 Crore like (i) necessary specification, certification for the products (ii) evaluation of the products on security aspects and (iii) all security domain specialized services, other than the product procurement, from CDAC, by entering into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), taking into account the special expertise of CDAC in the area of Security Domain
- (c) Permit ELCOT to carry out the hardware procurement activities worth of Rs.11.89 Crore relating to implementation of the Cyber Security Architecture for Tamil Nadu (CSA-TN) through open tender.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O. No.55865/Fin(Ind)/2018, Dated 30.10.2018 .
