ORDER:-

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued for conducting Crop Yield Competitions at State and District Level during 2012-2013 and a sum of Rs.14.08 lakh was sanctioned. In his letter second read above, the Director of Agriculture has sent proposals for continuing these Crop Yield Competitions at State and District Level during 2013-2014 and requested to sanction a sum of Rs.12.20 lakh for conducting 62 Nos. of District Level Competitions and Rs.1.80 lakh to conduct 6 Nos. of State Level Competitions and Rs.1.00 lakh for tour travel allowance, totaling Rs.15.00 lakhs for both District and State Level Competitions so as to achieve the object of Crop Yield Competition.

2. The Director of Agriculture has also informed that the prize and awards to winners of State Level Crop Yield Competition for the year

2012-13 was not spent during 2012-2013 itself. The erratic behavior of both South West monsoon and North East Monsoon resulted the delay in receipt of crop yield details from the districts. However, the crop yield details were received completely during the last week of March 2013 and as per the guidelines the prize winners were also decided. He has also requested to provide unspent amount of Rs.1,80,000 to distribute the state level prize for the year 2012-13, in addition to the proposed amount for the year 2013-2014. The unspent amount of the State Level prizes for the year 2012-2013 are as detailed below:-

- 3. The Government after careful consideration have decided to continue the Prize Scheme as an incentive to the farmers who have optimized crop yields through efficient water management and advanced scientific techniques. Accordingly a sum of Rs.14.08 lakh (Rupees fourteen lakhs and eight thousand only) is sanctioned for conducting Crop Yield Competition at State and District Level during 2013 2014.
- 4. The Government also sanction a sum of Rs.1,80,000/- (Rupees one lakh eighty thousand only) for distribution of prize for the State Level Crop Yield Competition Prize winners (Annexure-VI) for the year 2012-2013 as detailed below:-

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 & 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2401 - 00 - Crop Husbandry - 102 Food grain Crops - Schemes in the twelfth Five Year Plan II State Plan - JD Crop Yield Competition - 04. Travel Expenses - 01. Tour Travelling Allowances" (DPC 2401-00-102-JD-0411) - Rs.8,000/-

59 Prizes and Awards (DPC 2401-00-102-JD-5907) - Rs.15,80,000/-

- 6. Necessary additional funds will be provided in RE/FMA 2013-14. Pending provision of such funds, the Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw and disburse the sanctioned amount in para 3 and 4 above. He is also requested to include this expenditure while sending RE/FMA 2013-14 proposal to Government in Finance (Agri) Department without fail.
- 7. The Director of Agriculture is requested to allocate District-wise target as per guidelines annexed (Annexure I-V) to this order within the overall financial limit so as to achieve the object of Crop Yield Competition.
- 8. The Enrolment Fee for participating in the Crop Yield Competition, collected from the farmers shall be credited to the following receipt head of account:-

"0401-00-Crop Husbandry –800-Other receipts-AJ Crop Yield Competition (DPC 0401-00-800-AJ-0009)".

- 9. The Government permit the Director of Agriculture and Joint Director of Agriculture of concerned districts to declare the winners for State and District respectively and to draw the Prize amount and distribute the Prizes to the winners.
- 10. The Government also permit the Director of Agriculture to change the crop under Crop Yield Competition, when the contingency arises.
- 11. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No. 63293/Agri/2013,dated 5.11.2013 and ASL No.1837 (one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven).

Annexure I

Guidelines to conduct Crop Yield Competition during 2013-2014

- 1. Minimum of 50 cents area should be harvested for any category of the crops.
- 2. State & District level Prizes will be declared based on maximum yield (with moisture) obtained on the date of harvest.
- 3. Competitions for State & District Level should be conducted separately.
- 4. Both Landowners and lease holders may participate in the competitions.
- 5. Crop Yield Competition will be conducted in the following crops:-Paddy, Groundnut, (Irrigated) & (Rainfed), Cholam (Irrigated), Cumbu (Irrigated), Greengram (Irrigated), Blackgram (Irrigated) & Maize.
- 6. Enrolment fees for the competition may be collected as detailed below:

8. Since high yielding varieties are cultivated in a large scale, minimum yield obtained should be as mentioned below:-

1. Paddy	***	4,000 Kg. /Ac.
2. Cholam (Irrigated)	•••	1,500 Kg. /Ac.
3. Cumbu (Irrigated)		1,000 Kg. /Ac.
4. Greengram & Blackgram (Irrigated)	•••	400 Kg. /Ac.
5. Groundnut (Irrigated)		2,500 Kg. /Ac.
6. Groundnut (Rainfed)		1,000 Kg. /Ac.
7. Maize	•••	2,000 Kg. /Ac.

- 9. Crop Yield Competition can be conducted in all the Districts except Chennai and Niligiris.
- 10. All the participants should fill up the format prescribed in Annexure II and submit to Assistant Director of Agriculture concerned along with Enrolment fees. Receipt for enrolment fees paid should be given to the participant.
- 11. The cut-off date for State Level C.Y.C. will be fixed by Director of Agriculture. Similarly for District Level the concerned Joint Director of Agriculture will fix the cut of date. Applications received after the cut-off date will not be considered.
- 12. The participant or the representative of the participant should inform the exact harvest date of crop in person or through Registered Post with Acknowledgement Due or by Telegram or over phone to the concerned Assistant Director of Agriculture & get the acknowledgement. Otherwise, the request of farmers will not be entertained and the enrolment fees will not be refunded. Intimation should be sent to Assistant Director of Agriculture at least 15 days in advance. Participants alone will be held responsible for any postal delay.
- 13. In the event of monsoon failure, natural disasters & crop not cultivated the specific crop wise Physical target earmarked to districts is not achieved, the Director of Agriculture may be authorized to re-allot the Physical target within the Financial Allocation.
- 14. With regard to District Level Competitions, the Asst. Director of Agriculture concerned will fix the harvest date in consultation with District Joint Directors of Agriculture. As regards to State Level Competitions, the District Joint Director of Agriculture will fix the harvest date and intimate to the Director of Agriculture well in advance so that a representative will attend the harvest.
- 15. The Competition will be conducted by the following committees. The committee for the District & State Level Competitions will be constituted as follows. At least any three-committee members should be present during the harvest. The committee will finalize the results.

STATE LEVEL:

- 1. Director of Agriculture (or) his representative
- 2. District Joint Director of agriculture (or) Representative other than the Assistant Director of Agriculture of the Block.
- 3. District Collector (or) his Representative

4. Any one of the three progressive farmers (Nominated by Director of Agriculture).

DISTRICT LEVEL:

- 1. District Joint Director of Agriculture (or) Representative other than the Asst. Director of Agriculture of the Block.
- 2 District Collector (or) his Representative
- 3. Assistant Director of Agriculture
- 4. Any One Asst. Director of Agriculture of the Districts other than the Asst, Director of Agriculture of the Block.
- 5. Any one of the Three Progressive farmers. (The farmers are selected by Joint Directors of Agriculture and approved by District Collectors) The State & District Level non-official committee constituted by the Director of Agriculture and Collector respectively are treated as Ist & IInd Class Committee for the purpose of tour performed in connection with the Crop Yield Competition.
- 16. For Paddy Crop SRI method should be followed.
- 17. All the Harvest plots taken for Crop Yield Competition will be supervised by Asst. Director of Agriculture. If the plot yield is found to be below the recommended yield for each crop, that particular plot will be declared as rejected and written statement may be obtained from the farmers stating the reason for rejection. The entrance fee will not be returned in that case.
- 18. The C.Y.C. conducting committee has got rights to reject the competitions that are violating the rules and try to win the prizes in unlawful ways. The committee should inform such type of action taken against these competitors to District Joint Director of Agriculture and Director of Agriculture.
- 19. The District Level Crop Yield Competition prize winners will be declared by District Joint Director of Agriculture.
- 20. The State Level Crop Yield Competition prize winners will be declared by the Director of Agriculture.
- 21. The District Level Crop Yield Competition prize awards will be drawn by the Joint Director of Agriculture and distributed to the prize winners.

- 22. The State Level Crop Yield Competition prize awards will be drawn by the Director of Agriculture and distributed to the prize winners by the Honourable Minister for Agriculture or in any of the Government functions in the district.
- 23. Prize amount will be distributed by means of Cheque / Demand Draft in the name of the Winners.
- 24. The Cheque / Demand Draft will be distributed to prize winners by selected representative of Village people such as Panchyat President or M. L.A., District Collectors during the Govt. public functions, village programmes and field days.
- 25. Any problem relating to the declaration of prizes will be examined by the Crop Yield Competition Committee. The committee will take the final decision.
