ORDER:

During the 16th State Level Sanctioning Committee meeting of National Agriculture Development Programme held on 02.04.2018, the project proposals of the Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services were approved for an amount of Rs.6003.51 lakh, for the year 2018-19.

2. In the letter 2nd read above, the Government of India have made an allocation of Rs.165.20 crore as their share under National Agriculture Development Programme for the year 2018-19 and released a sum of Rs.82.60 crore as first instalment. By adding the corresponding State share of Rs.110.13 crore, in the funding pattern of 60:40, between the Central Government and the State Government, the total allocation works out to Rs.275.33 Crore under National Agriculture Development Programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana for the year 2018-19.

3. In the letter 3rd read above, the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has prioritized the projects for an amount of Rs.1297.20 lakh to the Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services as follows:

4. The Hon'ble Minister for Animal Husbandry, among others, has made the following announcement on the floor of the Assembly on 01.06.2018:-

“கால்நடை நோய்களுக்கான தடுப்பூசிகள் கால்நடைகளுக்குப் போடப்படும் வரை குளிர் நிலையில் இருத்தல் வேண்டும். இத்துறையின் தடுப்பூசிக்கான குளிர் பதன சங்கிலித் தொடரை மேம்படுத்த ரூ.7.97 கோடி செலவில், 480 தொடர் குளிர்சாதனப் பெட்டிகள், ஒரு குளிர் பதன அறை, 1,061 குளிர் சாதனப் பெட்டிகள் மற்றும் 1,500 தடுப்பூசிப் பெட்டிகள் அனைத்து ஊராட்சி ஒன்றியங்களிலும் உள்ள கால்நடை நிலையங்களுக்கும் வழங்கப்படும். இதன்மூலம் கால்நடைகளுக்கு வழங்கப்படும் தடுப்பூசி மருந்துகளின் தரம் பெரிதும் பாதுகாக்கப்படும்.”

5. Subsequently, the Hon'ble Chief Minister, among others, has made the following announcement on the floor of the Assembly under Rule 110 of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly on 06.06.2018.

“கால்நடை வளர்ப்போருக்கும் விவசாயிகளுக்கும் மருத்துவம் மற்றும் ஈனியல் சம்பந்தமான நோய்களால் ஏற்படும் பொருளாதார இழப்பை தவிர்க்க, நவீன நோய்கண்டறியும் கருவிகளை கால்நடை நிலையங்களுக்கு வழங்குவது அவசியமாகும். அதனடிப்படையில், மாவட்டத்திற்கு ஒரு கால்நடை நிலையத்திற்கு என்ற அளவில், 32 கால்நடை நிலையங்களுக்கு தலா ஒரு நுண்ணலை நுண்ணாய்வுக் கருவியும், ஒரு கணினிமயமாக்கப்பட்ட ஊடுகதிர் கருவியும், 8 கோடியே 46 இலட்சம் ரூபாய் செலவில் வழங்கப்படும்.”

6. In the letters 5th read above, the Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services has sent the category wise fund allocation for the prioritized Project proposal in pursuance of the announcement made by the Hon'ble Minister for Animal Husbandry and the announcement made by the Hon'ble Chief Minister under

Rule 110 of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly to the tune of Rs.1297.20 lakh and requested to accord financial sanction for an amount of Rs.648.60 lakh being first installment for implementation of the following projects under National Agriculture Development Programme 2018-19.

7. With a view to implement the announcements made by the Hon'ble Chief Minister under Rule 110 of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly and the Hon'ble Minister for Animal Husbandry, the Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services has sent a revised proposal to the Government. After careful examination of the proposal of Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, the Government accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.1297.20 lakh and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.648.60 lakh (Rupees Six Crore forty eight lakh and sixty thousand only) being the 1st installment release to the Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services for implementation of the project Nos.16.49 and 16.50 under National Agriculture Development Programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2018-19 subject to the condition that under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted. The funding pattern of the scheme is 60:40 sharing basis between the Central and State Governments.

9. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para.7 above.

10. The funds available under existing Centrally Sponsored / Central Sector Schemes should invariably be tapped before using Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme funds for the above projects. The projects should follow centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.

11. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the schemes.

12. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the projects.

13. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services is directed to follow the RKVY - RAFTAAR operational guidelines while implementing the schemes.

14. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments' to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.
