ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, financial sanction for a sum of Rs.10.60 lakh has been accorded for the continuance of "Composting of Farm Waste through Pleurotus" scheme during the year 2018-2019 for distribution of 5000 kits, (each kit costs Rs.212/-) to the farmers at free of cost.

- 2. In the letter second read above, the Director of Agriculture has stated that the scheme "Composting of Farm Waste through Pleurotus" is an ongoing scheme and is in operation since 2003. Under the said scheme, 5000 kits (each kit costing of adopt keep containing 1 Kg Pleurotus, 5 Kg urea and one literature Pamphlet) at a cost of Rs.212/- per kit is proposed to be distributed to the farmers at free of cost and hence for production of 5000 kits, an amount of Rs.10.60 lakh is required.
- 3. The Director of Agriculture has further stated that since emphasis is laid on promotion of INM by State Government and Government of India, the scheme which aims to propagate the low cost technology among farmers may be sanctioned for continuing in 2019-20.
- 4. The Director of Agriculture has, therefore, requested the Government to accord sanction for further continuance of the scheme "Composting of Farm Waste through Pleurotus" during the year 2019-20 at a cost of Rs.10.60 lakh for distribution of 5000 kits (each kit costing Rs.212/-) to the farmers at free of cost.
- 5. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of Director of Agriculture and accord sanction for further continuance of the scheme of

"Composting of Farm Waste through Pleurotus" during the year 2019-2020 at a cost of Rs.10.60 lakh (Rupees Ten Lakh and sixty thousand only) for distribution of 5000 kits, to the famers (each kit costing Rs.212/-) at free of cost as detailed below:-

6. The amount sanctioned in para 3 above, shall be debited into the following Head of Account:-
