ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, financial sanction for a sum of Rs.1581.80 lakh [(i.e) Rs.900.00 lakh Government of India Share and Rs.681.80 lakh - State share] as 1st installment under Sub-Mission on Agricultural Extension under National Mission on Agricultural Extension and Technology (NMAET) towards implementation of Support to the State Extension Programme for Extension Reforms Scheme (ATMA) for the year 2017-18 has been accorded.

2. In the Government order second read above, in view of the diversion of funds to the tune of Rs.300.00 lakh for Samba package 2017, a sum of Rs.1355.45 lakh [(i.e) Rs.993.27 lakh as Government of India Share and Rs.662.18 lakh as State share] was released as 2nd installment to the Director of Agriculture.

- 3. In the Government order third read above, financial sanction for a sum of Rs.2000.00 lakh [(i.e) Rs.1200.00 lakh Government of India Share and Rs.800.00 lakh State share] as 3rd installment was accorded to the Director of Agriculture.
- 4. Now, in the letter fourth read above, the Government of India have released Rs.888.90 lakh, (Rs.402.55 lakh under SCPSC component and Rs.486.35 lakh under General component) as the 4th installment, towards "Sub-Mission on Agricultural Extension under National Mission on Agricultural Extension and Technology (NMAET) for implementation of Support to the State Extension Programme for Extension Reforms Scheme (ATMA)" during 2017-18 as detailed below:-

- 6.
