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### ORDER:

During the 13<sup>th</sup> State Level Sanctioning Committee meeting of National Agriculture Development Programme held on 05.06.2015 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government to sanction the project proposals for the year 2015-16 among others, the following proposals of Department of Agricultural Engineering were approved under Supplementary Agenda with observations as mentioned in the minutes of the above meeting:-

2. In the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Government of India have changed the sharing pattern from 50:50 to 60:40 between Centre & States with respect to RKVY scheme from 2015-16 onwards. Accordingly, the Government of India have finally allocated a sum of Rs.432.90 crore (Central Share Rs.259.74 crore : State Share Rs.173.16 crore).

3. Accordingly, the Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) has sent the proposals for the projects to the tune of Rs.330.00 lakh under National Agriculture Development Programme 2015-16 to Government for issue of orders.

4. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) and accord approval for the following detailed project proposals and sanction a sum of Rs.330.00 lakh (Rupees Three crore and thirty lakh only) for the above purpose to the implementing Agency i.e. Department of Agricultural Engineering under National Agriculture Development programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2015-16, subject to the condition that under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted. The funding pattern of the scheme is 60:40 sharing basis between the Central and State Governments:-

5. The funds available under existing Centrally Sponsored / Central Sector Schemes should invariably be tapped before using Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme funds for the above projects. The projects should follow centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. The Department of Agricultural Engineering should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the Head of Account and Component wise details are as follows:-

7. Necessary additional funds will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16. Pending provision of such funds in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16, the Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 4 above. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2015-16. He is also requested to include this item of expenditure while sending proposals for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16 and also to send necessary explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2015-16 to Government in Finance (Agri) Department without fail.

8. The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) is permitted to procure the entire quantity of 275 Nos. of Agricultural Implements and attachments at a cost of Rs.170.00 lakh towards implementation of the project “Procurement of Tractor drawn Implements for the available Higher Horse Power Tractors of Agricultural Engineering Department”.

9. The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) is permitted to procure agricultural Implements and accessories for hiring purpose through the Assistant Executive Engineers of the Districts duly collecting the approved hire charges from beneficiaries for the above said project.

10. The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) is authorized to draw and disburse an amount of Rs.180.00 lakh to the firms after effecting the supply for the above said project.

11. The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the schemes.

12. The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the projects.

13. The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) is directed to follow the respective operational guidelines while implementing the schemes.

14. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments' to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.

15. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10<sup>th</sup> of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.
