ORDER:

During the 13th State Level Sanctioning Committee meeting of National Agriculture Development Programme held on 05.06.2015 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government to sanction the project proposals for the year 2015-16, the following proposals of Tamil Nadu Agricultural University were approved with observations as mentioned in the minutes of the above meeting:-

2. Accordingly, the Director, Centre for Agricultural and Rural Development Studies, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University has submitted the above proposals to Government for issue of orders. He has also stated that in respect of PP.No.13.20 and PP.No.13.21, Indian Council for Agricultural Research (ICAR), New Delhi has given concurrence for the above projects.

3. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposals of Director, Centre for Agricultural and Rural Development Studies, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University and accord approval for the following detailed project proposals and sanction a sum of Rs.2322.82 lakh (Rupees Twenty three crore twenty two lakh and eighty two thousand only) for the above purpose to the implementing Agency i.e. Tamil Nadu Agricultural University under National Agriculture Development programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2015-16 subject to the condition that under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted. The funding pattern of the scheme is 60:40 sharing basis between the Central and State Governments:-

4. The funds available under existing Centrally Sponsored / Central Sector Schemes should invariably be tapped before using Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme funds for the above projects. The projects should follow centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. The Tamil Nadu Agricultural University should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.

5. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the schemes.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

2415-Agricultural Research and Education – 01-Crop Husbandry-120-Assistance to other Institutions – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – II State Plan- JD- Grants to Tamil Nadu Agricultural University – Schemes under National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP-RKVY) 09–Grants-in-Aid-03 Grants for Specific Schemes.

7. Necessary additional funds of Rs.2322.82 lakh will be provided in Revised Estimates / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by way of Specific Inclusion in Final Supplementary Estimate 2015-16. Pending provision of such funds, the Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above. He is also requested to include this expenditure while sending the proposal for Revised Estimates / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16 and also to send necessary explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2015-16 to Government in Finance (Agri) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

8. The Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above to the Comptroller, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University through crossed cheque.

9. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the respective projects.

10. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University is directed to follow the respective operational guidelines while implementing the schemes.

11. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments' to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.

12. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10th of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.
