ORDER:-

During the 13th State Level Sanctioning Committee meeting of National Agriculture Development Programme held on 05.06.2015 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government to sanction the project proposals for the year 2015-16, the following proposals of Department of Fisheries were approved under supplementary agenda with observations as mentioned in the minutes of the above meeting:-

2. In the letter 2nd read above, the Government of India have changed the sharing pattern from 50:50 to 60:40 between Centre & State with respect to Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana scheme from 2015-16 onwards. Accordingly, the

Government of India have finally allocated a sum of Rs.432.90 crore (Central Share Rs.259.74 crore : State Share Rs.173.16 crore).

- 3. Accordingly, the Commissioner of Fisheries has sent the proposal to the tune of Rs.292.77 lakh for the above projects to Government for issue of orders.
- 4. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposals of Commissioner of Fisheries and accord sanction for a sum Rs.292.77 lakh (Rupees Two crore ninety two lakh and seventy seven thousand only) for the above purpose to the implementing Agency i.e. Commissioner of Fisheries under National Agriculture Development programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2015-16, subject to the condition that under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted. The funding pattern of the scheme is 60:40 sharing basis between the Central and State Governments:-

- 5. The funds available under existing Centrally Sponsored / Central Sector Schemes should invariably be tapped before using Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme funds for the above projects. The projects should follow centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. The Commissioner of Fisheries should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.
- 6. The Commissioner of Fisheries should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the schemes.
- 7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the Head of Account and component wise details of the projects as mentioned in the Annexure to this order.
- 8. Necessary additional funds of Rs.292.77 lakh will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16. Pending provision of such funds in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16, the Commissioner of Fisheries is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 4 above. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2015-16. He is also requested to include this item of expenditure sanctioned above, while sending proposals for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16 and also to send necessary explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2015-16 to Government in Finance (AH, D&F) Department without fail.

- 9. The Commissioner of Fisheries is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 4 above and deposit it in the P.D. account of the Commissioner of Fisheries.
- 10. The Commissioner of Fisheries shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the respective projects.
- 11. The Commissioner of Fisheries is directed to follow the respective operational guidelines while implementing the schemes.
- 12. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments' to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.
- 13. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10th of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.
- 14. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.70368/AH,D&F/2015, dated: 31.12.2015 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1805 (One Thousand Eight Hundred and Five).
