ORDER:

In the Government Order 1st read above, the Government have sanctioned and released a sum of Rs.82.75 crore as first instalment towards Central and State share for implementation of Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP) projects under Watershed Development Component of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) in Tamil Nadu during the year 2017-18 in the funding pattern of 60: 40 basis as per the common Guidelines of Government of India.

2. The Government of India in their letter second read above have sanctioned and released a sum of Rs.33.100 Crores towards the release of 2nd instalment of 60% Central share during 2017-18 for implementation of Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP) projects under Watershed Development

3. In the letter third read above, the Chief Executive Officer, State Level Nodal Agency, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has stated that the funding pattern of the scheme is 60% Central share and 40% State share. In the 2nd State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) held on 20.04.2017, the Annual Action Plan of PMKSY 2017-18 was approved and the same was sent to GOI for sanction of funds. Accordingly, the Government of India have sanctioned and released the 2nd instalment of 60% amount of Rs.33.10 Crores and the Government of Tamil Nadu have to release 40% share of Rs.22.06 Crores in line with the Central share as follows:-

- 4. The Chief Executive Officer, State Level Nodal Agency, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has therefore requested that a sum of Rs.55.16 crore (Central share of Rs.33.10 crore and State share of Rs.22.06 crore) may be sanctioned and released towards the Central and State share for implementing IWMP projects in Tamil Nadu for the year 2017-18.
- 5. He has also requested that the Director of Agriculture, Chennai may be authorized to draw the Central and State Share amount of Rs.55.16 Crore as per the relevant Head of account and to disburse the amount to the Chief Executive Officer, State Level Nodal Agency for depositing in the savings bank account opened for the purpose and further release to District Watershed Development Agencies (DWDA) of concerned districts for implementation of Watershed Development Component of PMKSY during the year 2017-18 as per the Guidelines of the Government of India.

- 6. The Government after careful examination decided to accept the proposal of the Chief Executive Officer, State Level Nodal Agency, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency and accord sanction for a sum of Rs:55.166 Crore (Rupees Fifty five Crore sixteen lakh and Sixty thousand only) as Second instalment for implementation of Integrated Watershed Management Programme under Watershed Development Component of PMKSY in Tamil Nadu during the year 2017-18 in the sharing pattern of 60:40 basis by Centre and State as per the Common Guidelines of Government of India. As per the guidelines, 1% of the amount sanctioned above shall be utilized for monitoring and 1% for evaluation of Integrated Watershed Management Programme Projects.
- 7. The amount sanctioned in paragraph 6 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2501-Special Programmes for Rural Development – 05 Wasteland Development – 101 – National Wasteland Development Programmes - Schemes shared between State and Centre – UB Integrated Watershed Management Programme – 09 Grants-in-aid – 03 Grants for Specific Schemes. (DPC 2501-05-101-UB-0938) – Rs.44,70,00,000.

"2501-Special Programmes for Rural Development – 05 Wasteland Development – 793 – Special Central Assistance for Scheduled Castes Component Plan – Schemes shared between State and Centre – UA - Integrated Watershed Management Programme under Special Component plan for Scheduled Castes – 09 Grants-in-aid – 03 Grants for Specific Schemes (DPC 2501-05-793-UA-0935) – Rs.10,46,60,000.

- 8. The Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 6 above.
- 9. The Director of Agriculture is hereby authorised to draw and disburse the said amount to the Chief Executive Officer, State Level Nodal Agency, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency for depositing in the Savings Bank Account maintained in Indian Overseas Bank, Guindy Branch opened for the purpose and for further release of funds to Project Officer / Joint Director of Agriculture of District Watershed Development Agencies of concerned districts for the implementation of Integrated Watershed Management Programme projects as per the Common Guidelines of Government of India.
- 10. The Chief Executive Officer, State Level Nodal Agency, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is authorized to utilize the amount earmarked for monitoring & evaluation of Integrated Watershed Management Programme projects. The detailed guidelines and instructions issued vide Government D.O. Letter 4th read above shall be scrupulously followed in the implementation without any deviation.
