ORDER:-

In the Government order 3rd read above, the Government have accorded administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.195.50 lakh and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.97.75 lakh towards implementation of the project proposal of Department of Cooperation under National Agriculture Development Programme 2016-17.

- 2. In the letter 4th read above, the Government of India have released additional fund of Rs.50.00 crore as its 60% share under National Agriculture Development Programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2016-17 for completion of ongoing projects approved by the State Level Sanctioning Committee of the State in its meeting held on 19.02.2016. The corresponding 40% State share is Rs.33.33 crore.
- 3. As requested earlier by the Registrar of Cooperative Societies, now, the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has requested the Government to provide authorization for the 2nd instalment amount of Rs.97.75 lakh towards implementation of the following project under National Agriculture Development Programme, 2016-17:-

- 4. The Government after careful examination, accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.97.75 lakh (Rupees Ninety Seven lakh and Seventy five thousand only) as 2nd installent towards implementation of the above proposal of the Registrar of Cooperative Societies under National Agriculture Development programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2016-17 subject to the condition that under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted. The funding pattern of the scheme is 60:40 sharing basis between the Centre and State Governments.
- 5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

2401-00 Crop Husbandry – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – 112 Development of Pulses – III Centrally Sponsored – SB Installation of Pulses Processing units in Cooperative Marketing Society under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme 09 Grants in Aid – 02 Grants for Creation of Capital assets.

- 6. The funds available under existing Centrally Sponsored / Central Sector Schemes should invariably be tapped before using Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme funds for the above projects. The projects should follow centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. The Registrar of Cooperative Societies should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.
- 7. The Registrar of Cooperative Societies is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para. 4 above to the concerned.
- 8. The Registrar of Cooperative Societies should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates while implementation of the scheme.
- 9. The Registrar of Cooperative Societies shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the project.
- 10. The Registrar of Cooperative Societies is directed to follow the respective operational guidelines while implementing the scheme.
- 11. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments' to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.
- 12. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10th of the subsequent month under intimation to the Government without fail.
