ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, among others, orders were issued according administrative approval for implementation of Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana in all the districts of Tamil Nadu except Chennai during 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 as per the existing Government of India guidelines and instructions issued thereon and also accorded financial sanction for an amount of Rs.634.7438 crore (Agriculture: Rs.621.1542 crore; Horticulture: Rs.13.5896 crore) during the year 2019 – 2020 towards settlement of State Share of premium subsidy, Payments for Professional and Special Services, advertisement and contingencies as provided in the Budget Estimate 2019-2020.

- 2. In the Government Order second read above orders have been issued notifying the Crops (Paddy II (Samba / Thaladi / Pishanam), Maize II, Cotton II & Onion II) Districts, Firkas, Revenue Villages for the Special Season 2019-2020 under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana.
- 3. In his letter fourth read above, the Director of Agriculture has stated that in para 9 of the Government Order first read above, the Director of Agriculture had been authorized to draw and disburse the premium subsidy allotted for Agriculture Crops in advance to Agriculture Insurance Company of India Limited and to the other approved Insurance companies through Agriculture Insurance Company of India Limited as per the Government of India subsidy pattern in accordance to the claims submitted by the Implementing Agencies and to settle the pending premium subsidy claims of previous years raised by the Implementing Agencies based on the budget provision of 2019-2020. In Para No.10 of above said Government order, the Director of Agriculture had also been authorized to release the State share of advance subsidy (I instalment) equivalent to 50% of 80% of their respective share of subsidy in corresponding previous season subject to fulfillment of General Financial Rule (GFR) / Guidelines in the matter without waiting for coverage details for the ongoing season.

- 4. He has further stated that in their Proceedings third read above, an amount of Rs.212,95,03,694/- (Rs.163,43,22,720/- to the Agriculture Insurance Company of India Limited and Rs.49,51,80,974/- to the Oriental Insurance Company Limited) has been settled to the concerned Insurance Companies as State share of upfront subsidy for Special Season and Rabi other crops, 2019-2020 based on the available budget provision of 2019-2020. Now, the Agriculture Insurance Company of India Limited has requested to release a sum of Rs.476,33,60,381/- towards settlement of second instalment State Government Share of Premium Subsidy for Special & Rabi season, 2019-2020 and the Oriental Insurance Company Limited has requested to release a sum of Rs.103,65,06,855/- towards settlement of second instalment State Government Share of Premium Subsidy for Special season, 2019-2020 alone.
- 5. However, as the yield data for Special Season crops (Paddy III, Maize III and Cotton III) alone have been furnished by the Department of Economics & Statistics to Insurance Companies, the Subsidy amount sought by the Insurance Companies have been restricted to Special Season alone and hence the subsidy amount proposed by Agriculture Insurance Company of India Limited for other crops of Rabi Season, 2019-20 in their subsidy bill has not been considered. A comparative statement on the State share of premium subsidy auto-generated on Government of India portal and the premium subsidy bill raised by the Insurance companies (ICs) based on the Government of India portal data is furnished below:-

- 6. In view of the hardships faced by the farmers due to the Covid 19 linked lockdown, the Director of Agriculture has requested the Government to accord Financial sanction for a sum of Rs.485,46,92,015/- of which a sum of Rs.414,37,27,132/- is payable to the Agriculture Insurance Company of India Limited and Rs.71,09,64,883/- to the Oriental Insurance Company Limited towards settlement of second instalment State Government Share of Premium Subsidy for Special season, 2019-2020 alone.
- 7. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Agriculture, accord sanction for a sum of Rs.485,46,92,015/- (Rupees Four Hundred Eighty Five Crore Forty Six Lakh Ninety Two Thousand and Fifteen only) towards the settlement of second instalment State Share of premium subsidy under PMFBY for Special Season, 2019-2020 pertaining to Agriculture crops as detailed below:-

- (i). Rs.414,37,27,132 /- (Rupees Four Hundred Fourteen Crore, Thirty Seven Lakh, Twenty Seven Thousand One Hundred and Thirty Two only) to Agriculture Insurance Company of India Limited; and
- (ii). Rs. 71,09,64,883/- (Rupees Seventy One Crore, Nine Lakh, Sixty Four Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty Three only) to The Oriental Insurance Company Limited.
- 8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above shall be debited to the following heads of account:-
