#### ORDER:

During the 12<sup>th</sup> State Level Sanctioning Committee meeting of National Agriculture Development Programme held on 14.11.2014 under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government, the following project proposals of Department of Horticulture and Plantation Crops were approved under National Agriculture Development Programme for 2014-15:-

2. The Government of India have allocated Rs.279.95 crore under normal Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana to the State of Tamil Nadu under National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) for the year 2014-15.

- 3. Based on the comments of 12<sup>th</sup> State Level Sanctioning Committee and fund availability, the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops has sent the proposals to Government for issue of orders.
- 4. The Government, after careful examination, accord approval for the following detailed project proposals at a cost of Rs.1007.875 lakh and financial sanction of Rs.507.875 lakh (Rupees Five crore seven lakh eighty seven thousand and five hundred only) under National Agriculture Development programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana for 2015-16 for the above purpose to the implementing agency i.e. Department of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, subject to the condition that under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted:-

- 5. The Government direct that the project Establishing New State Horticulture Farms in five districts of Tamil Nadu shall be implemented in 3 years at a total cost of Rs.1000.00 lakh. Out of which, Rs.500.00 lakh is sanctioned now for 1<sup>st</sup> year programme of 2014-15. The balance Rs.500.00 lakh will be allocated during the year 2015-16 for 2<sup>nd</sup> year programme under National Agriculture Development Programme. The 3<sup>rd</sup> year programme will be the Production of planting material and demonstration of technologies. The new State Horticulture farms shall be established in the five districts of Villupuram, Perambalur, Tirunelveli, Tuticorin and Erode.
- 6. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is authorized to draw Rs.507.875 lakh sanctioned in para 4 above and disburse Rs.500.00 lakh to the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Horticulture Development Agency (TANHODA) for implementation of Establishing New State Horticulture Farms in five districts of Tamil Nadu and Rs.7.875 lakh to the district officers concerned for implementation of Cyclone Thane relief –II year Programme in Newly Established Cashew fields in Cuddalore District by relaxation on quarterly restriction of funds.
- 7. The funds available under existing Centrally Sponsored Central Sector Schemes should invariably be tapped before using Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme funds for the above project. The project should follow centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. The Department of Horticulture and Plantation Crops should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.
- 8. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops / Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Horticulture Development Agency, should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the scheme.

- 9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the Head of Account as mentioned in the Annexure to this order.
- 10. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops to follow the operational guidelines of National Agriculture Development Programme while implementing the above scheme.
- 11. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the HOD's concerned to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.
- 12. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency to send the monthly progress report to Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10<sup>th</sup> of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.
- 13. Necessary additional funds will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above by the way of Re-appropriation under the head of account 2401 00 800 KF 11 01. Pending provision of such funds in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2014-15, the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is permitted to draw the amount sanctioned in para 4 above and to incur the expenditure to implement the scheme. This should be brought to the notice of Legislative by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2015-16. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is requested to include the expenditure sanctioned above, while sending the Budget Proposal for Revised Estimates / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16 and also to send necessary Explanatory Notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2015-16 to Finance (BG-I) Department without fail.
- 14. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the HOD's concerned to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.
- 15. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency to send the monthly progress report to Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10<sup>th</sup> of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.
