ORDER:

In the Government Order 1st read above orders have been issued to sanction an unspent amount of Rs.3317.03 lakh for the year 2019-2020 towards the implementation of Sub Mission on Agricultural Mechanization (SMAM) during the year 2020-2021. Further the Chief Engineer(Agricultural Engineering) has been directed to send the proposal for getting permission to utilize the amount of Rs.490.46 Lakh for the component "Financial Assistance for procurement of Agricultural Machinery and Equipment" towards the payment for the machinery distributed already through DBT portal during the year 2019-2020.

2) Accordingly, now the Chief Engineer(Agricultural Engineering) has stated that in the original proposal sent to Government for getting Government Order vide his letter dated 11.05.2020, it is stated that out of the total unspent amount of Rs.1049.74 Lakh for the component "Financial Assistance for procurement of Agricultural Machinery and Equipment" an amount of Rs.490.46 Lakh (Rs.346.48 Lakh under General Category and an amount of Rs.143.98 Lakh under Special Component Plan Category) has to be utilized for the payment of subsidy amount for the machinery supplied, but physical verification is pending, re-verification is pending and subsidy approval is pending as the lock down period implemented due to COVID-19 virus in the last week of March 2020 itself including the non-processing of bills for which payment file generated towards the Financial Assistance for procurement of Agricultural Machinery and Equipment through DBT portal developed by Government of India.

3) The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) has stated that during the physical verification by the scheme implementing officers now, only the eligible applications are taken up for subsidy release and the pending payment amount is now worked out to Rs.433.57 Lakh. Out of Rs.433.57 Lakh for which payment to be made, an amount of Rs.300.50 Lakh under General Category and an amount of Rs.133.07 Lakh under Special Component Plan Category. - 5) Further he has requested to permit him to utilize the balance amount of Rs.56.89 Lakh (Rs.45.98 Lakh under General Category and Rs.10.91 Lakh under Special Component Plan Category) in the originally proposed pending payment amount of Rs.490.46 Lakh towards the distribution of any of the Agricultural Machinery mentioned under the component "Financial Assistance for procurement of Agricultural Machinery and Equipment" within the respective Head of Accounts.
- 6) The Government after careful consideration, accept the proposal of Chief Engineer(Agricultural Engineering) and issue the following orders:
 - i. To permit the Chief Engineer(Agricultural Engineering) to utilize the balance amount of Rs.56.89 Lakh (Rs.45.98 Lakh under General Category and Rs.10.91 Lakh under Special Component Plan Category) in the originally proposed pending payment amount of Rs.490.46 Lakh towards the distribution of any of the Agricultural Machinery mentioned under the component "Financial Assistance for procurement of Agricultural Machinery and Equipment" within the respective Head of Accounts.
