## ORDER.

In the G.O. first read above orders were issued towards sanction for a sum of Rs.3,50,82,667/-(Government of India share 2,23,93,667 and State Share Rs. 1,26,89,000) towards implementation of NeGP-A in the State of Tamil Nadu during 2015-16 under 50:50 sharing basis between Centre and State.

- 2. In the meanwhile, in their letter second read above, Government of India have revised the amount sanctioned under the sharing pattern of 60:40 between the Center and the State.
- 3. The Director of Agriculture in his letter third read above has also informed that out of an amount of Rs. 3,50,82,667 under 50:50 sharing basis, an amount of Rs.2,83,20,000/- has not been utilized towards site preparation. Initially, the site preparation cost was planned to keep minimum 3 computers per Block, 5 Computers per district office and 20 each for state head quarters and State Agricultural Universities under centralized purchase plan by Government of India. Subsequently, the Government of India have decided to decentralize the procurement of systems and accessories by the State Government themselves based on the actual requirement and space constraints at the respective offices. Hence, the fund allocated for the site preparation cost has not been utilized so far.

- 4. Now, the Commissioner of Agriculture has sent proposals towards sanction for a sum of Rs. 2,84,49,726/- (which includes 60% of Government of India share of Rs.1,70,69,836/- and 40% states share of Rs. 1,13,79,890/-) towards the implementation of National e-Governance plan for Agriculture (NeGP-A).
- 5. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Commissioner of Agriculture and to accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs. 2,84,49,726/-(Rupees Two Crore Eighty Four Lakh Forty Nine Thousand and Seven Hundred and Twenty Six Only) (Government of India share: 1,70,69,836 + state share Rs.1,13,79,890/-) towards the implementation of NeGPA in the State of Tamil Nadu as detailed below:-

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to under the following head of account:-

2401-00 Crop Husbandry – 109 – Extension and Farmers Training Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year plan – VI – schemes shared between State and Centre UD – National e-Governance plan in Agriculture and National Mission on Agricultural Extension Technology – 09-Grants-in-aid-03-Grants for specific schemes – (DPC – code-2401-00-109-UD-0934)

7. Necessary additional funds will be provided in Revised Budget Estimate/Revised Estimate/Final Modified Appropriation 2016-17 under the head of account 2401-00-109-UD-09 03. However this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by way of Specific Inclusion in the Revised Budget Estimate/supplementary Estimates 2016-17. Pending provision of such funds, the Commissioner of Agriculture is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 5 above. He is requested to include this expenditure while sending the proposal for RBE/RE/Final Modified Appropriation 2016-17 and also to send necessary explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Revised Budget Estimate / Supplementary Estimates 2016-17 to Government (Agriculture / BG-1)Department at the appropriate time without fail.

- 8. The Commissioner of Agriculture is permitted to undertake the activities of Procurement of computers, UPS & printers, Appointment of consultant for SPMU and Development of Application software through M/S.ELCOT.
- 9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No. 28645/Agri./2016,dated. 17.05.2016 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.229(Two Hundred and Twenty Nine).
