2. Accordingly, the Director of Agricultural Marketing and Agri. Business has submitted the above proposal to Government for issue of orders.

3. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of Director of Agricultural Marketing and Agri. Business and accord approval for the following detailed project proposal and sanction a sum Rs.72.00 lakh (Rupees Seventy two lakh only) (Rs.36.00 lakh GOI share:Rs.36.00 lakh State share) for the above purpose to the implementing Agency i.e. Department of Agricultural Marketing and Agri – Business under National Agriculture Development programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2015-16 subject to the condition that under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted. The funding pattern of the scheme is 50:50 sharing basis between the Central and State Government:-

The funds available under existing Centrally Sponsored / Central Sector Schemes should invariably be tapped before using Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme funds for the above project. The project should follow centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. The Department of Agricultural Marketing and Agri. Business should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.

5. The Director of Agricultural Marketing and Agri. Business should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the scheme.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the Head of Account and component wise details of the project as mentioned in the Annexure to this order.

7. The Director of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business is directed to apply for release of funds as and when Government of India funds are credited into State Government account.

8. The Director of Agricultural Marketing and Agri. Business shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the project.

9. The Director of Agricultural Marketing and Agri. Business is directed to follow the Small Farmers Agriculture Business Consortium (SFAC) guidelines while implementing the scheme.

10. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments' to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.

11. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10th of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.
