ORDER:

During the 13th State Level Sanctioning Committee meeting of National Agriculture Development Programme held on 05.06.2015 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government to sanction the project proposals for the year 2015-16, the following proposals of Tamil Nadu Agricultural University were approved with observations as mentioned in the minutes of the above meeting:-

2. Accordingly, the Director, CARDS, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University has submitted the above proposals to Government for issue of orders.

3. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposals of Director, CARDS, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University and accord approval for the following detailed project proposals and administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.486.00 lakh (Rupees Four crore and eighty six lakh only) (Rs.243.00 lakh GOI share: Rs.243.00 lakh State share) for the above purpose to the implementing Agency i.e. Tamil Nadu Agricultural University under National Agriculture Development programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2015-16 subject to the condition that under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted. The funding pattern of the scheme is 50:50 sharing basis between the Central and State Governments:-

4. The funds available under existing Centrally Sponsored / Central Sector Schemes should invariably be tapped before using Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme funds for the above projects. The projects should follow centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. The Tamil Nadu Agricultural University should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.

5. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the schemes.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

2415-Agricultural Research and Education – 01-Crop Husbandry-120-Assistance to other Institutions – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – II State Plan- JD- Grants to Tamil Nadu Agricultural University – Schemes under National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP-RKVY) 09–Grants-in-Aid-03 Grants for Specific Schemes.

7. The Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above to the Comptroller, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University through crossed cheque.

8. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the respective projects.

9. The Director of Agriculture is requested to apply for release of funds as and when Government of India funds are credited into State Government account.

10. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University is directed to follow the respective operational guidelines while implementing the schemes.

11. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments' to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.

12. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10th of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.


