### ORDER:

During the 14<sup>th</sup> State Level Sanctioning Committee meeting of National Agriculture Development Programme held on 19.02.2016 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government to sanction the project proposals for the year 2016-17 among others, the following proposals of Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University were approved with observations as mentioned in the minutes of the above meeting:-

2. In the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, The Government of India have made interim allocation of Rs.509.55 crore in the funding pattern of 60:40 under Normal National Agriculture Development Programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (Production Growth, Infrastructure and assets and Flexi fund streams) for the year 2016-17 (Central share – Rs.305.73 crore + State share – Rs.203.82 crore). The Government of India has released its 1<sup>st</sup> installment Central share of Rs.152.87 crore.

3. Accordingly, the Director of Research, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University has sent the project proposals along with details of compliance of the State Level Sanctioning Committee resolutions for the above projects to the tune of Rs.629.91 lakh under National Agriculture Development Programme, 2016-17 to Government for issue of orders.

4. The Government after careful examination, accept the above proposals of Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University and accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs. 629.91 lakh and release a sum of Rs.314.955 lakh (Rupees Three crore fourteen lakh ninety five thousand and five hundred only) as 1<sup>st</sup> installment for the above purpose to the implementing Agency i.e. Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University under National Agriculture Development programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2016-17, subject to the condition that under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted. The final installment will be released after the release of Government of India 2<sup>nd</sup> and final installment. The funding pattern of the scheme is 60:40 sharing basis between the Centre and State Governments.

5. The funds available under existing Centrally Sponsored / Central Sector Schemes should invariably be tapped before using Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme funds for the above projects. The projects should follow centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

2415 Agricultural Research and Education – 03 Animal Husbandry – 277 Education – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – II State Plan – JD National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP/RKVY) – Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University - 09 Grants-in-Aid – 03 Grants for Specific Schemes”.

7. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 4 above to the Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University through crossed cheque / RTGS.

8. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the schemes.

9. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the projects.

10. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University is directed to follow the respective operational guidelines while implementing the schemes.

11. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments' to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.

12. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10<sup>th</sup> of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.

13. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.27700/AHD&F/2016, dated: 03.06.2016.
