ORDER:

During the 14th State Level Sanctioning Committee meeting of National Agriculture Development Programme held on 19.02.2016 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government to sanction the project proposals for the year 2016-17, among others, the following proposal of Tamil Nadu Fisheries University was approved with observations as mentioned in the minutes of the above meeting:-

2. In the letter 2nd read above, The Government of India have made interim allocation of Rs.509.55 crore in the funding pattern of 60:40 under Normal National Agriculture Development Programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (Production Growth, Infrastructure and assets and Flexi fund streams) for the year 2016-17 (Central share – Rs.305.73 crore + State share – Rs.203.82 crore). The Government of India have released its 1st installment Central share of Rs.152.87 crore.

3. The Deputy Director General (Fisheries Science), ICAR, NewDelhi in his comments along with other observations has remarked that the Budget proposed seems to be very high, especially under capital heads.

4. Accordingly, the Dean, Fisheries College and Research Institute, Ponneri under Tamil Nadu Fisheries University has sent the revised project proposal based on the ICAR comments along with details of compliance of the State Level Sanctioning Committee resolutions for the above project to the tune of Rs.211.00 lakh under National Agriculture Development Programme, 2016-17 to Government for issue of orders

5. The Government after careful examination, accept the following proposal of Tamil Nadu Fisheries University and accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs. 211.00 lakh and release a sum of Rs.105.50 lakh (Rupees One crore five lakh and fifty thousand only) as 1st installment for the above purpose to the implementing Agency i.e. Tamil Nadu Fisheries University under National Agriculture Development programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2016-17, subject to the condition that under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted. The final installment will be released after the release of Government of India 2nd and final installment. The funding pattern of the scheme is 60:40 sharing basis between the Centre and State Governments:-

6. The funds available under existing Centrally Sponsored / Central Sector Schemes should invariably be tapped before using Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme funds for the above projects. The projects should follow centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Fisheries University should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

8. Necessary additional funds of Rs.105.50 lakh will be provided in RBE / Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2016-17. Pending provision of such funds in RBE / Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2016-17, the Commissioner of Fisheries is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 5 above to the Tamil Nadu Fisheries University through crossed cheque / RTGS. He is requested to include the above expenditure while sending proposal for RBE / Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2016-17 to Government in Finance (AHD&F) Department at an appropriate time. However the above expenditure shall be brought to notice of the Legislative Assembly by a Specific inclusion in the RBE/Supplementary Estimates 2016-17. The Commissioner of Fisheries is also requested to send necessary draft explanatory notes to the Government in Finance (AHD&F) Department for the specific inclusion of the above expenditure in the RBE / Supplementary Estimates for the year 2016-17 at the appropriate time without fail.

9. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Fisheries University should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the scheme.

10. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Fisheries University shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the project.

11. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Fisheries University is directed to follow the respective operational guidelines while implementing the scheme.

12. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments' to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.

13. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10th of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.
