#### ORDER:

In the Government Order third read above, Government sanctioned a sum of Rs.2833.333 lakh as first instalment for implementation of Rainfed Area Development (RAD) component under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture(NMSA) for the year 2017-2018.

2. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency, in his letter 8<sup>th</sup> read above has informed that presently under the Rainfed Area Development component of National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture was approved for an amount of Rs.6401.91 lakh with sharing pattern of 60:40 between Centre and State for the year 2017-18 out of allocation of Rs.3400.00 lakh, Rs.1700.00 lakh was released as first instalment and the State have issued an order for an amount of Rs.2833.33 lakh including State share of Rs.1133.33 lakh vide Government Order third read above. The Government of India have now released an amount of Rs.1700.00 lakh as second installment and the corresponding state

share works out to Rs.1133.33 lakh for the implementing departments have proposed the requirement of funds as detailed below:-

- 3. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has therefore requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.2833.333 lakh as per the proposals received from the implementing departments viz. Agriculture, Horticulture, Agricultural Engineering, Agricultural Marketing & Agri Business, and Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency.
- 4. The Government after careful examination accept the proposals of the Director of Agriculture, Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering), Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business and the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency and accord approval for the proposals of the implementing Departments and sanction Rs.2833.333 lakh (Rupees Twenty Eight Crore Thirty Three Lakh and Thirty Three Thousand Three Hundred only) (GOI share 1700.00 lakh + State 1133.333 lakh) as second instalment towards implementation of the Rainfed Area Development component under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture during 2017-18 as detailed below:-

The funding pattern of the scheme is 60:40 sharing between the Central and State Governments.

- 5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the Heads of account and component wise details of the projects, as mentioned in the Annexures I V to this order.
- 6. Necessary provision are provided in RE 2017-18 under the relevant head of account. The Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 4 above to the Head of the Departments concerned viz., Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering), Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business and the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency through Electronic Clearing System (ECS).
- 7. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops may be permitted to re-allot the target within the district based on the requirement and Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Horticulture Development Agency (TANHODA), may be authorised to operate the account through district.
- 8. The concerned Assistant Directors of Agriculture are permitted to draw an advance amount of Rs.28.00 lakh for conducting training programme at Rs.10,000/-per training.
- 9. The implementing Departments should scrupulously follow the centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance while implementing the projects and they should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.
- 10. The implementing Departments should ensure proper implementation of the projects and complete them on time. The respective Head of the Departments should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the project.
- 11. The implementing Departments should monitor the implementation process and progress at the State & District levels effectively and to furnish the monthly progress reports to the Nodal Agency and to the Government.
- 12. The implementing Departments shall scrupulously follow the National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture guidelines issued by the Government of India while implementing the projects.
- 13. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10<sup>th</sup> of the subsequent month under intimation to the Government without fail.
- 14. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.3990/Agri/2018, dated 23.01.2018.
