Agriculture –Sanction accorded for Rs.64.240 lakhs as second instalment by adjusting the State Share fund Rs.34.264 lakh (excess amount of first instalment) based on the Government of India's second instalment release with a revised sharing pattern 60:40 Centre and State for implementing the component Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana of NMSA 2015-2016— Orders - Issued.

ORDER:-

In the Government of India's letter first read above, the Government of India have approved a plan for an amount of Rs.799.46 lakh with a sharing pattern of 50:50 Central & State Share and released first instalment as Rs.299.80 lakh for implementation of Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (PKVY) one of the components of National Mission on Sustainable Agriculture(NMSA).

- 2. In the G.O. second read above, the Government of Tamil Nadu have sanctioned an amount of Rs.599.60 lakh including State share of Rs.299.80 lakh for implementation of the projects of PKVY under NMSA 2015-16.
- 3. Now, in the letter 3rd read above, the Government of India have released Rs.99.93 lakh as second instalment with the changed sharing pattern

of 60:40 (Centre and State) with a revised total outlay of Rs.666.22 lakh which is lower than the original allocation of Rs.799.60 lakh for implementation of PKVY.

- 4. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency(TAWDEVA) has informed in his consolidated proposal fourth read above, originally 112 clusters have proposed under PKVY component for the year 2015-2016. Due to the reduction in allocation, the number of clusters needs to be reduced. Hence, for the year 2015-2016 only 93 clusters would be taken up for implementation under PKVY component of NMSA. As per the PKVY guidelines the amount required for one cluster is Rs.7.0674 lakh. Though the amount sanctioned by the Government of India is Rs.666.22 lakh, it might be taken as only Rs.663.840 lakh for implementation of the scheme in 93 clusters for 2015-2016 by ignoring the fraction of Rs.2.38 lakh, since a full cluster could not be taken up for implementation with this amount.
- 5. As the State had already released Rs.299.80 lakh as first instalment instead of Rs.265.536 lakh, Rs.34.264 lakh is excess than the States liability based on the revised sharing pattern of 60:40. Hence, the State does not need to provide any further share. The excess amount of Rs.34.264 lakh might be adjusted from the Government of India's fund.
- 6. Hence, the Executive Director, TAWDEVA has requested the Government to issue order for sanction of worked out amount of Rs.64.24 lakh by adjusting the State share Rs.34.264 lakh already released in first instalment under PKVY component of NMSA for the year 2015-2016. The ignored amount from the GOI's original release of Rs.2.38 lakh to be adjusted for the programme during the year 2016-2017. Hence it is proposed to implement five clusters in five districts by Commissioner of Agriculture and four clusters in four districts by Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops. The Commissioner of Agriculture has furnished in detail as given below:-

7. Further, the Executive Director, TAWDEVA has requested to sanction a sum of Rs.0.633 lakh proportionately on the release of Rs.64.240 lakh as second instalment administrative expenditure with regard to implementation of PKVY under NMSA. The COA may be authorised to draw the sanctioned

administrative expenditure amount from the Head of Account provided for PKVY and disburse it to the ED, TAWDEVA, Chennai for depositing into the savings Bank Account for incurring the expenditure at TAWDEVA.

- 8. The Government after careful examination has accepted the proposal of Executive Director, TAWDEVA accordingly sanction a sum of Rs.64.240 lakh (Rupees Sixty four lakh and twenty four thousand only) for implementation of PKVY component under NMSA 2015-2016 as annexed with the Government Order. The ignored fraction amount from the original release of Government of India, Rs.2.38 lakh to be adjusted for the programme during 2016-2017.
- 9. Necessary funds will be provided in Revised Budget Estimate/Revised Estimate/Final Modified Appropriation 2016-2017, pending provision of such funds, the Commissioner of Agiculture is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 8 above. He is also directed to include this expenditure sanctioned above while sending the Budget proposal for RBE/RE/FMA 2016-2017 proposal to Government in Finance (Agri) Department.
- 10. The above sanctioned amount is allocated in separate Head of Accounts for the implementing Departments i.e. Agriculture, Horticulture and TAWDEVA as annexed to this Government order.
- 11. The Head of Departments are permitted/authorised to draw and utilize the funds sanctioned for NMSA scheme from 2016-17 onwards.
- 12. The department wise, physical and financial targetwise, category wise and head of account wise fund allocated are annexed herewith.
- 13. The implementing Departments are ordered to follow the NMSA Guidelines issued by the Government of India and to follow the cost norms and pattern of assistance while implementing the projects scrupulously.
- 14. The implementing Departments shall ensure proper implementation of the projects and complete them in time. The implementing Department shall monitor the implementation process and progress at the State and District levels effectively and to furnish the monthly progress reports to the Nodal Agency and to the Government.
- 15. The Commissioner of Agriculture is authorised to draw the sanctioned administrative expenditure amount Rs.0.633 lakh from the Head of Account provided for PKVY and disburse it to the Executive Director, TAWDEVA, Chennai for depositing into the savings Bank Account for incurring the expenditure at TAWDEVA.
- 16. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is permitted to reallocate the target based on the requirement and the Managing Director, TANHODA is authorised to operate the account through districts.
