ORDER:

During the 13th State Level Sanctioning Committee meeting of National Agriculture Development Programme held on 05.06.2015 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government to sanction the project proposals for the year 2015-16, the following proposals of Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services were approved with observations as mentioned in the minutes of the above meeting:-

2. Accordingly, the Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services has submitted proposals to Government for issue of orders.

3. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposals of Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services and accord approval for the above detailed project proposals and sanction a sum Rs.946.00 lakh (Rupees Nine crore and forty six lakh only) (Rs.473.00 lakh GOI share : Rs.473.00 lakh State share) for the above purpose to the implementing Agency i.e. Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services under National Agriculture Development programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2015-16, subject to the condition that under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted. The funding pattern of the scheme is 50:50 sharing basis by the Central and State Governments.

4. The funds available under existing Centrally Sponsored / Central Sector Schemes should invariably be tapped before using Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme funds for the above projects. The projects should follow centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. The Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.

5. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the schemes.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

7. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above.

8. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services is permitted to reallocate the target with respect to breed and number of animals purchased among the departmental farms in the event of any hurdles being encountered during the course of implementation of the scheme. He is also permitted to authorize the purchase committee to decide the price to be offered for the purchase of livestock at the time of purchase depending on market conditions. Further, he is authorized to alter the expenditure incurred under the various components without exceeding the overall financial allocation for the project "Introduction of New Livestock Genetic Pool in the Departmental Farms".

9. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services is permitted to reallocate the target within the selected farms or to other farms in the event of any hurdles being encountered during the course of implementation of the scheme, "Provision of Modern Livestock shelter for Augmenting Productivity at the District Livestock Farms".

10. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the respective projects.

11. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services is directed to follow the respective guidelines while implementing the schemes.

12. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments' to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.

13. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10th of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.
