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### ORDER:

During the 13<sup>th</sup> State Level Sanctioning Committee meeting of National Agriculture Development Programme held on 05.06.2015 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government to sanction the project proposals for the year 2015-16, the following proposals of Department of Agricultural Engineering were approved with observations as mentioned in the minutes of the above meeting:-

2. Accordingly, the Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) has sent the combined proposal for the project Agricultural Mechanization in Tamil Nadu to the tune of Rs.1300.00 lakh and for the project Soil Conservation in the catchments of River Valley project in Tamil Nadu to the tune of Rs.445.00 lakh totaling to Rs.1745.00 lakh.

3. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) and accord approval for the following detailed project proposal and sanction a sum of Rs.445.00 lakh (Rupees Four crore and forty five lakh only) (Rs.222.50 lakh GOI share: Rs.222.50 lakh State share) for the above purpose to the implementing Agency i.e. Department of Agricultural Engineering under National Agriculture Development programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2015-16 subject to the condition that under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted. The funding pattern of the scheme is 50:50 sharing basis between the Central and State Governments:-

The funds available under existing Centrally Sponsored / Central Sector Schemes should invariably be tapped before using Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme funds for the above project. The projects should follow centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. The Department of Agricultural Engineering should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.

5. The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the scheme.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account and the component wise details of the projects as mentioned in the Annexure to this order:-

7. Necessary additional funds of Rs.445.00 lakh will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16. Pending provision of such funds in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16, the Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned



in para 3 above by relaxing quarterly restriction of funds. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates. He is also requested to include this item of expenditure while sending proposals for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16 and also to send necessary explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2015-16 to Government in Finance (Agri / BG-I) Department without fail.

8. The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the project.

9. The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) is directed to follow the respective operational guidelines while implementing the scheme.

10. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments' to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.

11. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10<sup>th</sup> of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.
