### ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above administrative sanction was accorded for a sum of Rs.504.45 lakh and financial sanction for Rs.252.23 lakh (50%) was given for implementation of the projects of Tamil Nadu Fisheries University under National Agriculture Development Programme during the year 2014-15.

2. During the 13<sup>th</sup> State Level Sanctioning Committee meeting of National Agriculture Development Programme held on 05.06.2015 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government to sanction the project proposals for the year 2015-16, the following proposals of Tamil Nadu Fisheries University were approved to release the balance amount admissible for implementation of the scheme during the year 2015-16 along with observations as mentioned in the minutes of the above meeting:-

2. Accordingly, the Registrar, Tamil Nadu Fisheries University has submitted the above proposals to Government for issue of orders.

3. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposals of Registrar, Tamil Nadu Fisheries University and accord approval for the release of a sum of Rs.126.11 lakh (Rupees One crore twenty six lakh and eleven thousand only) being the 50% of the amount due for the second year of the scheme i.e., 2015-16, as against Rs.252.22 lakh for the above purpose to the implementing Agency i.e. Tamil Nadu Fisheries University under National Agriculture Development programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2015-16 subject to the condition that under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted:-

4. The funds available under existing Centrally Sponsored / Central Sector Schemes should invariably be tapped before using Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme funds for the above projects. The projects should follow centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. The Tamil Nadu Fisheries University should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.

5. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Fisheries University should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the schemes.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

7. The Commissioner of Fisheries is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above to the Registrar, Tamil Nadu Fisheries University.

8. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Fisheries University shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the respective projects.

9. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Fisheries University is directed to follow the respective guidelines while implementing the schemes.

10. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments' to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.

11. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10<sup>th</sup> of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.
