ORDER:

In the Government order second read above, orders have been issued according administrative sanction at an outlay of Rs.1471.44 lakh (Rupees Fourteen Crore Seventy one lakh and forty four thousand only) for implementing Coconut Development Board assisted schemes in Tamil Nadu during 2021-2022.

2. In the letter third read above, the Coconut Development Board, Kochi has conveyed Administrative Approval for an amount of Rs.1591.49 lakh for implementing the Coconut Development Board assisted schemes in Tamil Nadu during the year 2022-2023. Further, it was also informed that, out of Rs.1591.49 lakh sanctioned for the State, Rs.1315.63 lakh (Board's share Rs.1167.13 lakh + State's share Rs.146.25 lakh + Beneficiary's contribution Rs.2.25 lakh) will be implemented through State Agricultural Department, Rs.16.00 lakh through SAU/ ICAR/PSU/KVK and Rs.259.86 lakh will be Coconut Development Board direct implementation.
