## ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, administrative approval was accorded for the implementation of the Coconut Development Board assisted schemes in Tamil Nadu during 2016 - 2017 at a cost of Rs. 187.500 lakh of which the share of the Coconut Development Board is Rs.137.50 lakh and share of the State Government is Rs. 50.000 lakh.

2. The Coconut Development Board in its letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above has released an amount of Rs. 43,74,119/- to the Government of Tamil Nadu for utilization under the scheme, "Laying out of Demonstration Plots" as detailed below:-

3. The Commissioner of Agriculture in his proposal dated 19.07.2016 has stated that the Coconut Development Board has now released a sum of Rs. 43,74,119/- and

the same has been remitted into the Government account and requested to issue financial sanction for a sum of Rs. 43,75,000/- (Coconut Development Board release Rs. 43,74,119 + unspent balance amount Rs. 881/-) for implementation of the scheme "Integrated Farming in Coconut Holdings for Productivity Improvement – Laying out of Demonstration Plots Maintenance" Maintenance plots of 250 ha. for during 2016-2017.

- 4. After careful examination, sanction is hereby accorded for a sum of Rs.43,75,000/- (Rupes forty three lakh and seventy five thousand only) which includes the unspent balance amount of Rs.881/- (Rupees Eight hundred and eighty one only) for implementation of the scheme "Integrated Farming in Coconut Holding for Productivity improvement-Laying out of Demonstration Plots scheme" for maintenance of plots of 250 ha. during 2016-2017.
- 5. The expenditure sanctioned in para-4 above shall be debited under the following head of account:-

2401 – 00 Crop Husbandry 114 – Development of Oilseeds schemes in the Twelfth five year plan III - Centrally Sponsored Schemes - SB – Integrated farming in Coconut holding for productivity improvement – 11 – Subsidies – 01 – Individual based subsidy.

- 6. The Commissioner of Agriculture is authorized to draw and disburse the expenditure as sanctioned in para 4 above.
- 7. The Commissioner of Agriculture is directed to send detailed periodical reports to Government on the implementation of the schemes for information and review. He is also requested to utilize the entire amount during Financial year 2016-2017 for implementation of scheme.
- 8. The progress reports in respect of the scheme indicating physical and financial achievements including the receipts accrued, if any, shall be furnished to Coconut Development Board regularly by the 10<sup>th</sup> of every month. In addition to the physical and financial progress reports, quantitative report on the outcome of the programme shall be sent to Coconut Development Board with reference to the objective of the programme.
- 9. The Commissioner of Agriculture is also instructed to ensure that the utilization certificate and details of unspent balance, if any, are furnished to the Coconut Development Board / Government in time.
- 10. The operational guidelines and other directions issued by the Coconut Development Board shall be followed strictly while implementing the schemes.
- 11. The Commissioner of Agriculture is also requested to give suitable directions to the District Joint Directors of Agriculture, Deputy Directors of Agriculture and Assistant Directors of Agriculture and field units to extend necessary assistance in implementing the programme benefitting the farming community.

- 12. The Commissioner of Agriculture is also requested to ensure that the Physical and Financial target fixed for the project are to be achieved fully for the year 2015-2016 without fail.
- 13. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.43489/Agriculture/2016, dated 15.08.2016.
