in the G.O. first read above, administrative sanction was accorded for the implementation of Mission on Sustainable Dryland Agriculture for development of 1,000 Dryland clusters @ 1,000 Ha of Dryland per cluster in three phases for a total outlay of Rs.802.90 Crore in a period of 4 years from 2016-17 to 2019-20. Under this Scheme among others, a sum of Rs.20.00 crore @ Rs.10 Lakhs per cluster has been earmarked for implementation of Animal Husbandry activities in 200 clusters with the following components:-

- 2. In the G.O sixth read above, sanction was accorded for a sum of Rs.20.00 Crore, indicating that would be Rs.14.00 Crore from Mission fund and Rs.6.00 Crore from Dovetailed fund towards implementation of the above components in 200 clusters @ Rs.10.00 Lakh each in 2017-18.
- 3. In the G.Os fourth and seventh read above, among others, sanction was accorded for a sum of Rs.3.00 Crore each totaling Rs.6.00 Crore under National Agricultural Development Programme, for implementing the components of Animal Husbandry Department in dryland Clusters during 2017-18.
- 4. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services in the letter fifth read above has stated that cost of Mineral mixture as per Aavin quotation is Rs.50/- per kg and hence requested to clarify whether the quantity of Mineral mixture can be increased keeping the number of animals per cluster constant or number of animals to be increased either 250 or 1000 per cluster or include sheep and goats in the medical camp.
- 5. The Government have examined the request of the Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services and accordingly, in partial modification of the orders issued in the Government Orders first and fourth read above, permit the Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services to implement the components at a total outlay of Rs.10 Lakh per cluster as given below.

- 6. The Government also permit the Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services to implement the animal husbandry package in all 200 dryland clusters identified in 25 districts by the Department of Agriculture for a total outlay of Rs.20.00 Crore @ Rs.10.00 Lakh each (Rs.14.00 Crore under Mission fund in 16 districts and Rs.6.00 Crore under National Agricultural Development Programme in 9 districts) in 2017-18 as detailed in the Annexure to this Order.
- 7. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services is also directed to include small ruminants like sheep and goat as an alternative option if the required number of cattle is not available in the cluster.
- 8. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services is directed to place the modified implementation of Animal Husbandry Department components under National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) in the ensuing State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) of NADP for ratification.
