ORDER:

During the 13th State Level Sanctioning Committee meeting of National Agriculture Development Programme held on 05.06.2015 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government to sanction the project proposals for the year 2015-16, the following proposal of Registrar, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University was approved with observations as mentioned in the minutes of the above meeting:-

2. Accordingly, the Registrar, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University has submitted proposal to Government for issue of orders.

3. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of Registrar, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University and accord approval for the project "Animal Mobile Medical Ambulance for Rural Veterinary Care in Tamil Nadu" and accord sanction a sum of Rs.633.96 lakh (Rupees Six crore thirty three lakh and ninety six thousand only) (Rs.316.98 lakh GOI share : Rs.316.98 lakh State share) for the above purpose to the implementing Agency i.e. Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University under National Agriculture Development programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2015-16, subject to the condition that the Agricultural Technology Management Agency (ATMA) cost norms should be strictly followed with respect to the training component and under no circumstances any deviation from the decision of the State Level Sanctioning Committee is permitted. The funding pattern of the scheme is 50:50 sharing basis by

the Central and State Governments. A committee should be formed under the Chairmanship of the Secretary, Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries Department comprising of the Vice-Chancellor, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (TANUVAS), Director of Animal Husbandry, representatives from 108 ambulance services, officials of the Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project (TNHSP) and other officials of TANUVAS, Directorate of Animal Husbandry etc., to finalize the modus operandi of the scheme, design of the vehicle coordinates with Directorate of Animal Husbandry, 108 ambulance services etc., so as to provide whole some services to live stock farms.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

2415 Agricultural Research and Education – 03 Animal Husbandry – 277 Education – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – II State Plan – JD National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP/RKVY) – Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University - 09 Grants-in-Aid – 03 Grants for Specific Schemes”.

5. Necessary additional funds of Rs.633.96 lakh will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16. Pending provision of such funds in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16, the Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in the Final Supplementary Estimate 2015-16. He is also requested to include this item of expenditure while sending proposals for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2015-16 and also send draft explanatory note for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2015-16 to Government in Finance (Agri / BG-I) Department without fail.

6. The funds available under existing Centrally Sponsored / Central Sector Schemes should invariably be tapped before using Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme funds for the above project. The project should follow centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. The Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.

7. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the scheme.

8. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above to the Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University through crossed cheque / RTGS.

9. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the respective project.

10. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University is directed to follow the respective guidelines while implementing the scheme.

11. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments' to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.

12. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10th of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.

13. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.75/DS(PW)/2015, dated:17.12.2015 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1618 (One Thousand Six Hundred and Eighteen).
