

ABSTRACT

Agriculture – Implementation of Market Intervention Scheme (MIS) for Oil palm Fresh Fruit Bunches (FFBs) procured during 2019–2020 - Administrative approval and financial sanction for Rs.146.5816 lakh under State funds towards payment of differential cost between Fresh Fruit Bunches price fixed and Market Intervention Scheme (MIS) price per MT of Fresh Fruit Bunches to Oilpalm Growers – Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

During the Budget Session 2020-2021 interalia, the following announcement was made by the Hon'ble Minister (Agriculture):-

"25. எண்ணெய்ப்பனை விவசாயிகளின் நலனை பாதுகாக்கும் வகையில், 2019–2020 ஆம் ஆண்டில் ஆலைகளுக்கு எண்ணெய்ப்பனை குலைகளை வழங்கிய விவசாயிகளுக்கு ஒரு கோடியே 65 இலட்சம் ரூபாய் சந்தை தலையீட்டு விலை வித்தியாசத் தொகையாக வழங்கப்படும்."

2) In the 25th Project Management Committee on Oilpalm meeting held on 16.04.2018 under the Chairmanship of Agricultural Production Commissioner and Principal Secretary to Government, Agriculture Department, it was decided to send a proposal on Market Intervention Scheme to meet the differential cost between Fresh Fruit Bunches price fixed every month for Tamil Nadu as per the formula and assumed Market Intervention Scheme (MIS) price of Rs.8,415/- per MT of Fresh Fruit Bunches for 2017-2018 to support the Oil Palm growers on the lines of similar scheme being implemented in the States like Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka & Gujarat which are implementing Market Intervention Scheme with 100% State's share.

- 3) In the Government Order 2nd read above, Government accorded administrative and financial sanction for the implementation of Market Intervention Scheme for a sum of Rs.1.3035 crore for 6995.922 MT of Oil palm Fresh Fruit Bunches procured in 2017–2018 with 100% financial assistance from the State fund.
- 4) In the Government Order 3rd read above, Government have accorded administrative sanction and financial sanction for implementation of Market Intervention Scheme for a sum of Rs.99.36 lakh for 7034.110 MT of Oil palm Fresh Fruit Bunches procured in 2018–2019.
- 5) Now, the Director of Agriculture has sent a proposal to the Government to accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.146.5816 lakh for the implementation of Market Intervention Scheme for 3809.536 MT of Oil palm Fresh Fruit Bunches procured in 2019–2020 with 100% financial assistance from the State fund. The following mode of operation is proposed to be adopted in respect of Market Intervention Scheme (MIS) payment to the oilpalm growers:-

MODE OF OPERATION OF PAYMENT TO THE OIL PALM GROWERS UNDER Market Intervention Scheme:-

- The respective entrepreneur operating in the particular district should furnish the farmer wise, month wise supply of Fresh Fruit Bunches during the financial year 2019-20 indicating the quantity of Fresh Fruit Bunches procured, Fresh Fruit Bunches price paid to the farmers in Tamil Nadu and differential amount to be paid to the farmer have to be furnished block wise to the Assistant Directors of Agriculture.
- The Assistant Director of Agriculture, on the receipt of the abstract of claim from the entrepreneur, should process the same and submit the claim to the treasury within 15 days.
- ➤ The payment of Market Intervention Scheme should be credited to the farmer's bank account to which Fresh Fruit Bunches market disposal price is being paid regularly as Direct Benefit Transfer through Electronic Clearing System (ECS).
- ➤ The Agricultural Officer/ Deputy Agricultural Officer concerned should maintain a register in which the details of Farmer name, Survey No., Area covered, Uprooted area if any, quantity of Fresh Fruit Bunches supplied to the firm and Differential cost now paid should be recorded before the submission of claim to the treasury.
- 6) The Director of Agriculture has also requested orders on the following:-
 - (i) to authorize him to draw and disburse the amount to concerned Joint Director of Agriculture to implement the scheme, pending provisions of additional allocation in Revised Estimate 2020-2021.

- (ii) Necessary budget provisions may be made to disburse the amount to Oil Palm farmers.
- (iii) Since the differential cost has to be settled to Oil Palm farmers, in single installment, the amount to be allotted under the Head of Account 2401-00-114-JB may be exempted from quarterly appropriation.
- 7) The Government, after careful examination of the above proposal of the Director of Agriculture, hereby accord administrative sanction and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.1,46,58,160/- (Rupees One Crore forty six lakh, fifty eight thousand one hundred and sixty only) towards Market Intervention Scheme (MIS) for 3809,536 MT of Oil palm Fresh Fruit Bunches procured in 2019–2020 as detailed in Annexure appended to this order.
- 8) The expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above shall be debited to the following Head of account:-

2401 – 00 - Crop Husbandry – 114 Development of Oilseeds – State's Expenditure –JB - Market Intervention Scheme for Procurement of Oil palm Fresh Fruit Bunches – 311 Subsidies – 01 Individual Based Subsidy.

(IFHRMS DPC: 2401-00-114-JB - 31101) (Old DPC: 2401-00-114-JB - 1115) - Rs.1,46,58,160/-

- 9) Necessary additional funds of Rs.1,45,95,000/- will be provided in Revised Estimate /Final Modified Appropriation 2020-2021, pending provision of such funds, the Director of Agriculture is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 7 above to the Joint Directors of Agriculture concerned. However, the expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2020-2021. The Director of Agriculture is directed to include this expenditure while sending the budget proposal for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2020-2021 and also send necessary draft explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2020-2021 to the Government in Finance (BG-I/Agri.) Department without fail.
- 10) The Director of Agriculture shall also ensure that on receipt of the abstract of farmer-wise claims from the Oil Palm entrepreneurs viz., Godrej Agrovet Limited, Vaidehi Palm Private Limited and Ruchi Soya Industries Limited, the Block Assistant Directors of Agriculture should process and submit the claim to the treasury within 15 days for disbursing the differential cost to the Oil Palm growers concerned.

- 11) The Director of Agriculture shall also ensure that the payment of differential cost is made directly to the farmers' account as Direct Benefit Transfer through Electronic Clearing System (ECS).
- 12) The Agricultural Officer / Deputy Agricultural Officer concerned should maintain a register in which the details of Farmer name, Survey No., Area covered, Uprooted area if any, quantity of Fresh Fruit Bunches supplied to the firm and Differential cost now paid should be recorded before the submission of claim to the treasury.
- 13) The Director of Agriculture is also directed to send a compliance report to Government on implementation of the scheme as ordered above.
