Agriculture - Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business - Construction of 46 Godowns in Regulated Markets at a cost of Rs.99.51 crore with the loan assistance from WIF-NABARD during the year 2017-18 - Administrative and financial sanction - Orders - Issued.

ORDER

In the letter first read above, the Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business has stated that in the 73rd Meeting of the High Power Committee of National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development, it has been suggested to send proposal for getting assistance from WIF-NABARD for construction of godowns in Agricultural Marketing Department. Accordingly, a detailed discussion was made with the Secretaries of Market Committees during the review meeting held on 31.8.2017 and the actual requirement has been worked out for the construction of 46 Godowns at a total estimate cost of Rs.99.51 crore as detailed below:-

2) The Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business has further stated that out of 46 works, 27 works at a cost of Rs.32.76 crore will be carried out by the Chief Engineer, Agricultural Engineering Department and 19 works at a cost of Rs.66.75 crore will be carried out by the Engineering wing of Tamil Nadu State Agricultural Marketing Board.

3) He has also furnished the source of funds for the construction of 46 Godowns at a total cost of Rs.99.51 crore as follows:-

95% of estimated cost for construction of Godowns will be met out by the NABARD -WIF Fund	Rs.94.5345 crore
5% will be met out by the concerned Market Committee / Tamil Nadu State Agricultural Marketing Board	Rs.4.9755 crore
Total Project cost	Rs.99.5100 crore

4) The above proposal was forwarded to the National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development in the letter second read above.

5) In the letter 3rd read above, the NABARD, among others, has given approval for the construction of 43 scientific storage warehouses in 43 regulated markets (total 46 Godowns) covering 16 districts from Warehouse Infrastructure Fund under NABARD at an outlay of Rs.99.51 crore and also sanctioned a sum of Rs.94.1260 crore.

6) The General Manager, NABARD has also requested to confirm the administrative approval on or before 2.2.2018 to enable them to issue detailed sanction letter. Further, he has stated that as per WIF Guidelines, if the Administrative Approval is not received within one month, the sanction will lapse and the State Government will have to submit the project as fresh proposal along with Administrative Approval. The State Government can draw upto 20% of the total Warehouse Infrastructure Fund Loan sanctioned as mobilisation advance, on acceptance of terms and conditions of the sanction.

7) The Government after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business and accord administrative sanction for the construction of 46 Godowns in Regulated Markets in their own lands at a total cost of Rs.99.51 crore (Rupees Ninety nine crore and fifty one lakh only) as detailed below with loan assistance from NABARD under WIF to the tune of Rs.94.1260 crore (95% of the total project, excluding Rs.43.00 lakh out of Rs.99.51 crore is ineligible cost) during the year 2017-18 and also sanction a sum of Rs.18.8252 crore (Rupees Eighteen crore, eighty two lakh and fifty two thousand only) as 20% mobilization fund advance out of Rs.94.1260 crore:-

8) The Government permit to treat the proposal as a single project and authorize the Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business to change the proposed places if required.

9) The Government also permit to carry out 19 works (10,000MT, 5000MT and 2000MT Godowns) at a cost of Rs.66.75 crore by the Engineering wing of Tamil Nadu State Agricultural Marketing Board and 27 works (1000MT and 500 MT Godowns) at a cost of Rs.32.76 crore by the Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) in the Regulated Market premises.

10) The Government permit the Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business to meet out the recurring expenditure of Rs.5.3840 crore (including ineligible cost of Rs.43.00 lakh) in connection with the maintenance of Godowns from the concerned Market Committee / Tamil Nadu State Agricultural Marketing Board.

11) The expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"4435- Capital Outlay on other Agriculture Programmes - 01 Marketing and Quality Control -101 Marketing Facilities - State's Expenditure - JI - Construction of Godowns at Regulated Markets with National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development Loan Assistance - 16 Major Works"

(DPC - 4435-01-101-JI- 1604)

12) The expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure shall initially be met by drawal of an advance from the contingency fund. The Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form-A appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules-1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. He is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2017-2018 to Finance (BG-I/Agri) Department at an appropriate time without fail.

13) The Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business is directed to implement the construction work by following the existing Financial Procedures / Government Orders while incurring the expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above. He is also directed to inform the progress of the work and expenditure made every month to Government.

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14) This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.5489/Agri/2018, dated 06.02.2018 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.2662 (Two Thousand Six Hundred and Sixty Two Only)


