Horticulture – Continuance of Integrated Horticulture Development Scheme – Implementation in Non-National Horticulture Mission (Non-NHM) Districts during 2016-17 – Sanction of Rs. 411.798 lakhs – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:-

In Government Order first read above, Government accorded sanction for implementation of Integrated Horticulture Development Scheme (IHDS) during 2015-16, in 9 Non-NHM Districts viz. Kancheepuram, Thiruvallur, Karur, Namakkal, Thiruvarur, Tuticorin, Nagapattinam, Thiruvannamalai and Virudhunagar Districts of Tamil Nadu at an outlay of Rs.334.89lakh.

- 2. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops in her letter second read above has sent a proposal for continuance of Integrated Horticulture Development Scheme (IHDS) in 9 Non-NHM Districts during 2016-2017, and requested to sanction a sum of Rs. 411.798 lakhs. She has stated that under this scheme, focus will be given to area expansion of Vegetables, Fruits, Spices, Flowers and Plantation crops. In respect of Vegetables and Flower crops, hybrid seed material and planting material will be distributed to farmers at 40% cost, upto 2 ha. In respect of Fruits, Spices and Plantation Crops, planting material and Seed & Seedlings of Spices will be distributed to farmers at 40% cost, upto 4 ha. She has also stated that, 20.01% of the total allocation under area expansion is proposed to be utilized for SC farmers and 1.10% is proposed to be utilized for ST farmers.
- 3. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, accord sanction for a sum of Rs. 411.798 lakhs (Rupees Four crore eleven lakh seventy nine thousand and eight hundred only) towards implementation of Integrated Horticulture Development Scheme (IHDS) in 9 Non-NHM Districts viz. Kancheepuram, Thiruvallur, Karur, Namakkal, Thiruvarur, Tuticorin, Nagapattinam, Thiruvannamalai and Virudhunagar during 2016-17. The funds shall be allocated as follows:-

General Category = Rs. 324.867 Lakh SC Category = Rs. 82.401 Lakh ST Category = Rs 4.530 Lakh

Total = Rs. 411.798 Lakh

- 4. The Head of Account under which the expenditure for the above scheme shall be debited and receipt credited are shown in the Annexure of this order.
- 5. Necessary funds will be provided in Revised Estimate/Final Modified Appropriation 2016-2017 under the relevant head of account. Pending provision of such funds, the Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is permitted to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above. However this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislative by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2016-17. The Director of Horticulture and Plantation Crops is directed to include the expenditure sanctioned above, while sending the proposal of Revised Estimate/Final Modified Appropriation 2016-17 and also to send necessary explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the supplementary Estimates 2016-17 to Government in Finance (Agriculture / BG-I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
 - 6. The crops will be distributed as following:

(i) Vegetable Crops:

Hybrid vegetable seeds will be distributed at 40% subsidy in total cost of cultivation /Hybrid seed materials gives higher yield tomato, brinjal, bhendi, beans, carrot, beetroot, cabbage, cauliflower etc will be distributed. A Beneficiary can avail benefit upto 2 ha.

(ii) Fruit Crops:

The pedigree planting materials of mango, sapota, aonla, guava etc, will be distributed at 40% subsidy in total cost of cultivation. A beneficiary can avail benefit upto 4 ha.

(iii) Spices crops:

Seed and seedlings of spices will be distributed at 40% subsidy in a total cost of cultivation to enhance area under spice crops in the potential districts. A beneficiary can avail benefit upto 4 ha.

(iv) Flower Crops:

The planting materials of flower crops will be distributed to farmers at 40% subsidy in total cost of cultivation. A beneficiary can avail benefit upto 2 ha.

(v) Plantation Crops:

The planting material of plantation crop are distributed at 40% subsidy in total cost of cultivation. A beneficiary can avail benefit upto 4 ha.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No. 59605/Agriculture/2016, dated 21.11.2016 and additional sanction ledger No. 1231 (One thousand two hundred and thirty one).
