ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Government of India have given approval for Annual Action Plan for implementation of National Food Security Mission-Commercial Crops for a sum of Rs.125.000 lakh (Government of India share Rs.75.000 lakh + State Share Rs.50.000 lakh) comprising NFSM- Cotton Rs.83.000 lakhs and NFSM - Sugarcane at

Rs.42.000 lakh for the year 2021-22, in the sharing pattern of 60:40 between Centre and State.

- 2. In the Government Order second read above, orders were issued for Administrative approval for a sum of Rs.5402.438 lakh (Government of India share Rs.3241.463 lakh + State Share Rs.2160.975 lakh) and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.1200.616 lakh (Government of India share Rs.720.370 lakh + State Share Rs.480.246 lakh) as First Instalment for the implementation of National Food Security Mission (NFSM)-Rice, Pulses, Coarse Cereals and Nutri Cereals, Targeting Rice Fallow Areas (TRFA) Pulses, Commercial Crops for the year 2021-22.
- 3. In the Letter third read above, the Government of India have conveyed the approval for Revised Annual Action Plan for the implementation of National Food Security Mission (NFSM) Commercial Crops Cotton for an amount Rs.283.00 lakh (GOI share Rs.170.000 lakh + State share Rs.113.000 lakh) in the sharing pattern of 60:40 between Central and State.
- 4. In the letter fourth read above, the Government of India have released the second instalment for a sum of Rs.42,50,000/- (Rupees Forty Two lakh and Fifty Thousand only). The Category-wise, Component-wise details (General, SC, ST) are as follows:-

The Director of Agriculture has therefore, requested the Government to accord Revised administrative approval for an outlay of Rs.325.000 lakh (Government of India share Rs.195.000 lakh + State Share Rs.130.000 lakh) for cotton and sugarcane and to accord financial sanction for Rs.70.833 lakh (Government of India share Rs.42.500 lakh + State Share Rs.28.333 lakh) as Second Instalment for the implementation of National Food Security Mission-Commercial Crops-Cotton during 2021-2022.
- 9. The Government, after careful examination, of the proposal of the Director of Agriculture, hereby accord Revised administrative approval

for an outlay of Rs.325.000 lakh (Government of India share Rs.195.000 lakh + State Share Rs.130.000 lakh) for NFSM-Commercial Crops - Cotton and Sugarcane and financial sanction for Rs.70,83,300/- (Rupees Seventy Lakh Eighty Three Thousand and Three Hundred only) (Government of India share Rs.42.500 lakh + State Share Rs.28.333 lakh) as Second Instalment for the implementation of National Food Security Mission-Commercial Crops-Cotton during 2021-2022. c)	Permission is accorded to authorize the Director of Agriculture to issue necessary executive instructions in continuation of the guidelines issued, as and when situation arises.
d)	Permission is accorded to permit the concerned Joint Directors of Agriculture to draw and disburse the amount pertaining to Bio Agents to the concerned production units as and when required.

- 12. The Government also direct the Director of Agriculture to strictly follow the detailed operational guidelines issued in the Government Order second read above, while implementing various components under National Food Security Mission Commercial Crops-Cotton for the year 2021-22.
- 13. The Director of Agriculture is further directed to submit the monthly progress report incorporating component wise Physical and Financial achievement report by 15th of every month regularly. The Annual Progress Report and Utilization Certificate in the prescribed format GFR–12(C) at the end of the year, to the Government of Tamil Nadu and Government of India.
