Order:-

In the letter first read above, the Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) has sent project proposal for Rehabilitation of Irrigation network in Chittar sub-basin in Tirunelveli District at a total cost of Rs.25.05 Crore under the National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development assistance.

- 2) In the letter second read above, the above said proposal has been forwarded to the National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) for availing loan assistance of Rs.25.05 crore under Rural Infrastructure Development Fund XXII for the year 2016-2017.
- 3) In the letter 3rd read above, the General Manager, National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) has stated that

the Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF) Project Sanctioning Committee (PSC) in its 162nd meeting held on 27.12.2016 has, interalia, approved the above project and sanctioned an amount of Rs.21.5175 Crore (i.e) 95% of the project cost of Rs.2265.00 lakhs approved by National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development out Rs.25.05 Crore (including Rs.2.40 crore stated as ineligible cost by National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development) for the Rehabilitation of Irrigation network in Chittar sub-basin in Tirunelveli District.

- The Government, after careful consideration, and based on the approval of National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) and accord administrative sanction for the Rehabilitation of Irrigation network in Chittar sub-basin in Tirunelveli District at a total cost of Rs.22.65 Crore (Rupees twenty two crore and sixty five lakh only) with loan assistance from National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development under Rural Infrastructure Development Fund -XXII to the tune of Rs.21.5175 Crores (95% of the approved project cost by National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development for Rs.22.65 Crore out of total cost of Rs.25.05 Crore including of Rs.2.40Crore stated as ineligible cost by NABARD and sanction a sum of Rs.4.3035 Crores (Rupees Four Crore, Thirty Lakhs and Thirty Five Thousand Only) as mobilisation advance (20% of the RIDF) for the Rehabilitation of Irrigation network in Chittar sub-basin in Tirunelveli District.
- 5) The amount sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following New Head of Account:-

"4402 – 00 – Capital outlay on Soil and Water Conservation – 102 – Soil Conservation Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – II – State Plan – JZ – Rehabilitation of Irrigation network in Chittar sub-basin under loan assistance from National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development – 16 – Major Works"

The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) is the Estimating, Re-conciling and Controlling authority for the above head of account. The Treasury Officer/Pay and Accounts Officer concerned is requested to open the above new head of account in their books.

6) The Chief Engineer (Agriculture Engineering) is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 4 above.

- 7) The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above constitute an item of "New Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the contingency fund. The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form-A appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules-1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. He is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2016-2017 to Finance (BG-I/Agri) Department at an appropriate time without fail.
- 8) The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) is directed to implement the above work by following the existing Financial Procedures and Government Orders while incurring the expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above. He is also directed to inform the progress of the work and expenditure made every month to Government.
- 9) This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.6684/(Finance) Agri/2017, dated 13.02.2017 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.2109 (Two thousand one hundred and nine)
