Agriculture – Establishment of 7 new Liquid Bio fertilizer production units – Permission to utilize the savings available under National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) towards the pending additional works to be completed in the Liquid Bio Fertilizer Production units in the districts of Thiruvallur, Villupuram, Vellore and Ariyalur – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

Based on the Announcement made under Rule 110 during 2014-15 in Government order first read above the Government have approved the scheme of "The establishment of new 7 Liquid Bio fertilizer production units" at a financial outlay of Rs.893.00 lakhs under National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) for the year 2014-2015.

- 2. Accordingly, in Government order 2nd read above initially an amount of Rs.10.00 lakhs was allocated during the first year of implementation of the project. In the Government order 3rd read above, an amount of Rs.300.00 lakhs under National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) 2015-2016 was sanctioned against the earmarked allocation of Rs.893.00 lakhs and in the Government letter 4th read above, the remaining amount of Rs.583.00 lakhs, out of total sanction of Rs.893.00 lakhs was sanctioned.
- 3. The Director of Agriculture in his letter 6th read above has stated that by utilizing the above sanctioned amount 7 New Liquid Bio Fertilizer Production units have been established at Madurai (Thirumangalam), Thiruvallur(Puzhal), Villupuram(Mugaiyur), Vellore (Gudiyatham), Ariyalur (Jeyakondam), Dindigul (Palani) and Sivagangai (Manamadurai) at a total cost of 883.00 lakhs. The civil work

and installation of instruments work are completed in Madurai, Sivagangai, Ariyalur and Dindigul. Installation of instruments work is in progress at Thiruvallur, Villupuram and Vellore.

4. The Director of Agriculture has also stated that the Joint Directors of Agriculture of Thiruvallur, Villupuram, Vellore and Ariyalur have informed that additional funds are required for the works such as providing required EB connection, Bore well, Providing passage platform and other electrical work accessories which are very essential for the smooth functioning of the laboratories and the details of additional funds required for the above districts for the essential works are detailed below:-

He has also stated that an additional amount of Rs.8,52,175/- is required for the completion of Liquid Bio fertilizer production units at Thiruvallur, Villupuram, Vellore and Ariyalur.

- 5. Further, the Director of Agriculture has informed that an amount of Rs.85,90,325/- (savings fund of National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) Initiative for Nutritional Security through Intensive Millets Promotion (INSIMP) scheme) is available in the savings bank account of Director of Agriculture. Under this scheme Rs.323.08 lakhs was allocated for Tamil Nadu Agricultural University (TNAU) for installation of processing units and an amount of Rs.85,90,325/- has been surrendered by Tamil Nadu Agricultural University (TNAU) as unspent and accrued interest.
- 6. The Director of Agriculture has therefore requested the Government, to grant necessary permission for utilizing an amount of Rs.8,52,175/- from the savings of National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) Initiative for Nutritional Security through Intensive Millets Promotion (INSIMP) scheme towards the pending additional works to be completed in Thiruvallur, Villupuram, Vellore and Ariyalur for the early establishment of Liquid Bio fertilizer production units.
- 7. The Government after careful examination of the above proposal of the Director of Agriculture, permit the Director of Agriculture for utilizing an amount of Rs.8,52,175/- (Rupees Eight lakhs fifty two thousand one hundred and

seventy five only) from the savings of National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) – Initiative for Nutritional Security through Intensive Millets Promotion (INSIMP) scheme towards the completion of pending additional works in the Liquid Bio-Fertilizer production units in Thiruvallur, Villupuram, Vellore and Ariyalur districts and direct to remit the balance savings amount into Government account immediately.
