## ORDER:

In the reference first read above, the Government of India have conveyed its approval for implementation of Reclamation of Problem Soils (RPS) on pilot basis as a sub-scheme of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) from 2016-17 and among others, earmarked a sum of Rs.6.67 crores to Tamil Nadu 2016-17 for Reclamation of Problem Soils (RPS). As requested by the Government of India, the State Action Plan (SAP) for the year 2016-17 under "Reclamation of Problem Soils" of the Chief Engineer, Agricultural Engineering Department has been forwarded to Government of India for consideration.

2. In the State Action Plan, the Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) has stated that the scheme, Reclamation of Problem Soils under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) has proposed to be implemented on pilot basis in Nagapattinann and Cuddalore District at a cost of Rs.667.00 lakhs, comprising the Central Share of Rs.400.00 lakhs and State Share of Rs.267.00 lakhs, the components / type of works and the expenditure involved are as indicated below:

3. The Government of India have accorded technical approval for the State Action Plan (approved by the Chairman of the State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) of National Agricultural Development Programme (NADP)) for reclamation of 1100 Ha area under "Reclamation of Problem Soils" as a Sub Scheme of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) at an estimated cost of Rs.667.00 lakhs comprising the Central share of Rs.400.00 lakhs and State's share of Rs.267.00 lakhs in the ratio of 60:40 between Central and State Government for implementation during 2016-17, on pilot basis with the upper limit of unit cost of Rs.60,000/- per ha and released Rs.200.00 lakhs as first instalment (50% of Central Share) to Government of Tamil Nadu under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) - Sub Scheme during 2016-17 for "Reclamation of Problem Soils". The equivalent 50% State share of Rs.133.50 lakhs has to be released as first instalment as matching share for implementing the above project.

4. The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) has informed that the following components are prioritized in Nagapattinam and Cuddalore Districts and proposed for the first installment of Rs.333.50 lakhs as detailed below:-

- 5. The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) has, therefore, requested the Government orders for implementation of Reclamation of Problem Soil, under Sub Scheme of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) for the year 2016-17 at a cost of Rs.667.00 lakhs and financial sanction for the release of first instalment of Rs.333.50 lakhs, to implement the project at Nagapattinam and Cuddalore Districts as indicated at para-4 above and for inclusion of Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) as one of the member of State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) on National Agricultural Development Programme (NADP).
- 6. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) and accord administrative sanction for implementation of Centrally Sponsored Scheme, 'Reclamation of Problem Soils', a sub-scheme of National Agricultural Development Programme (NADP) in Nagapattinam and Cuddalore District at the cost of Rs.667.00 lakhs. The Government also accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.333.50 lakhs (Rupees Three Crores thrity three lakhs and fifty thousand only) (Rs.200.00 lakhs as Government of India share and Rs.133.50 lakhs as matching share of State Government) as first instalment to Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) / Director of Agriculture to implement the Centrally Sponsored Scheme, "Reclamation of Problem soils" under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) for the year 2016-17 at Nagapattinam and Cuddalore District as indicated at para-5 above.

- 7. The Government direct that State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) and State Level Project Steering Committee (SLPSC), for National Agricultural Development Programme (NADP) is retained for "Reclamation of Problem Soils" which is a sub-scheme of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) and the Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) is included as a member in the above Committee. Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency (TAWDEVA) is appointed as a Nodal Agency for this scheme also as for National Agricultural Development Programme (NADP). The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) / Director of Agriculture is permitted to implement the scheme of Reclamation of Problem Soils, a Centrally Sponsored Scheme, a sub-scheme of National Agricultural Development Programme (NADP).
- 8. The expenditure sanctioned in para-6 above shall be debited to the following head of account.

- 9. The Director of Agriculture and the Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) is authorized to draw and incur the expenditure relevant to their department for the implementation of the project.
- 10. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency (TAWDEVA) is requested to place the above proposal in the ensuing State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) on National Agricultural Development Programme (NADP) for ratification.
- 11. Necessary funds will be provided in Final Modification Appropriation 2016-17 under the relevant head of account. Pending provision of such funds, the Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) / Director of Agriculture is permitted to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para-6 above. However, the expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by the specific inclusion in the supplementary Estimates 2016-17. The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) / Director of Agriculture is requested to include this expenditure, while sending the proposal for Final Modified Appropriation 2016-17 and also sent the necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion the above expenditure in the Supplementary

Estimates 2016-17 to Government in Finance (BG-I/Agri) Department at appropriate time without fail.
