ORDER:-

In the Government order 3rd read above, the Government have accorded administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.311.78 lakh and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.155.89 lakh towards 2nd year and 3rd year implementation of the project proposals of Department of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business under National Agriculture Development Programme 2016 - 17.

2. In the letter 4th read above, the Government of India have released additional fund of Rs.50.00 crore as its 60% share under National Agriculture Development Programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana 2016 - 17 for completion of ongoing projects approved by the State Level Sanctioning Committee of the State in its meeting held on 19.02.2016. The corresponding 40% State share is Rs.33.33 crore.

3. As per the request made by the Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business, now, the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has requested the Government to provide authorization for the remaining amount of Rs.155.89 lakh towards 2nd year and 3rd year

The Government after careful examination of the proposal of Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing & Agri-Business, accord sanction for a sum of Rs.155.89 lakh (Rupees One crore fifty five lakh and eighty nine thousand only) as 2nd installment towards 2nd and 3rd year implementation of the above proposals of the Department of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business under National Agriculture Development Programme / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana during 2016 - 17. The funding pattern of the scheme is 60:40 sharing basis between the Centre and State Governments.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para.4 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account.

6. The Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business is permitted to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para.4 above.

7. The funds available under existing Centrally Sponsored / Central Sector Schemes should invariably be tapped before using Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana / National Agriculture Development Programme funds for the above projects. The

projects should follow centrally prescribed cost norms and approved pattern of assistance. Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing and Agriculture Business, should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.

8. The Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the schemes.

9. The Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business shall observe the comments / suggestions of State Level Sanctioning Committee while implementing the projects.

10. The Commissioner of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business is directed to follow the respective operational guidelines while implementing the schemes.

11. The Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency which is the Nodal Agency, in consultation with the Head of Departments' to prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes through RDMIS to ensure that they are adhered to by the implementing departments.

12. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10th of the subsequent month under intimation to this [Government without fail](#).
