ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, Administrative sanction was accorded for Implementation of National Mission on Oilseeds and Oilpalm (NMOOP) during 2017-18 at an outlay of Rs.1877.765 lakh comprising Rs.1205.00 Lakh for MM I – Oilseeds; Rs.491.383 Lakh for MM II – Oilpalm and Rs.181.382 Lakh for MM III – Tree borne oilseeds also sanctioned a sum of Rs.1233.840 Lakh comprising Rs. 877.470 Lakh for MM I – Oilseeds, Rs. 242.730 Lakh under MM II – Oil Palm and Rs. 113.640 Lakh for MM III – Tree borne oilseeds under National Mission on Oilseeds and Oil palm (NMOOP). In the Letter second read above, an amount of Rs.207.00 Lakh has been revalidated and permitted to utilize the same for the implementation of National Mission on Oilseeds and Oilpalm during the year 2017-18. In the G.O. fifth read above, a sum of Rs.162.850 lakh sanctioned as second installment comprising of Rs.117.000 lakh for MMI – (Oilseeds), Rs.32.350 lakh for MMII (Oilpalm) and Rs.13.500 Lakh for MM III -(Tree Borne Oilseeds) for implementation of National Mission on Oilseeds and Oilpalm (NMOOP).

2. The Government of India in their letter 3rd read above, have released a sum of Rs.148.055 lakh as third / final installment for implementation of National Mission on Oilseeds and Oilpalm (NMOOP) during the year 2017-2018 as detailed below: -

installment comprising of Rs.26.357 lakh for MM I – (Oilseeds), Rs.145.847 lakh for MM II-(Oilpalm) and Rs.51.925 Lakh for MM III-(Tree Borne Oilseeds) for implementation of National Mission on Oilseeds and Oilpalm (NMOOP) on 60:40 sharing basis between Centre and State during 2017-2018 as detailed in the Annexure I, II and III appended to this Government Order. The Government permit the District Joint Directors of Agriculture / Assistant Directors of Agriculture concerned to draw the required amount for training as advance to conduct the **officers training** in coordination with Tamil Nadu Agriculture University, Coimbatore/ other resource personnel, if any under MM II-Oil Palm and MM III- Tree Borne Oilseeds and necessary adjustment bill shall be presented within the prescribed time.
- 8. The Government also permit the District Joint Directors of Agriculture / Assistant Directors of Agriculture concerned to draw the required amount for training as advance to conduct **farmers training** as per the target under MM II-Oil Palm and MM III- Tree Borne Oilseeds and necessary adjustment bill shall be presented within the prescribed time.
- 9. The Director of Agriculture is authorized to issue necessary executive instructions in continuation of the guidelines issued by Government of India as and when situation arises.
- 10. The Government also permit the Director of Agriculture/ District Joint Directors of Agriculture to draw & incur the expenditure for contingencies under the component **Mission Management Expenses** under MM-I(Oilseeds), MM-II (oil Palm) & MM-III (TBOs).
- 11. The Director of Agriculture shall also ensure that the above scheme is implemented in accordance with the guidelines issued by the Government of India and Physical/Financial targets are achieved without any shortfall and also follow the instructions issued in this regard by Government of India. Also directed to send the monthly progress report to reach by fifth of subsequent month to Government and also to Government of India covering both physical and financial achievements.
