ORDER:

The Government of India, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare have introduced a new scheme Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana w.e.f 2015-16 with the overreaching vision of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) to ensure access to some means of protective irrigation to all agricultural farms in the country, to produce 'per drop more crop', thus bringing much desired rural prosperity. The Government of India have also communicated necessary Guidelines in connection with implementation of the scheme. (Guidelines can be accessed from DAC Website (www.agricoop.nic.in))

2. Programme Components

(i) Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP)

To focus on faster completion of ongoing Major and Medium irrigation including National Projects.

(ii) PMKSY (Har Khet Ko Pani)

It covers Command Area Development & Water Management 2, Minor Irrigation (both surface and ground water) and RRR of water bodies3)

(iii) PMKSY (Per Drop More Crop)

(a) Programme management, preparation of State / District Irrigation Plan, approval of annual action plan, Monitoring etc.

(b) Promoting efficient water conveyance and precision water application

devices like drips, sprinklers, pivots, rain-guns in the farm.

(c) Extension activities for promotion of scientific moisture conservation and agronomic measure including cropping alignment to maximize use of available water including rainfall and minimize irrigation requirement (Jal sarankchan).

(iv) PMKSY (Watershed Development)

- (a) Effective management of runoff water and improved soil & moisture conservation activities such as ridge area treatment, drainage line treatment, rain water harvesting, in-situ moisture conservation and other allied activities on watershed basis.
- (b) Converging with MGNREGS for creation of water source to full potential in identified backward rainfed block including renovation of traditional water bodies.

3. Action Plan

District Irrigation Plans (DIPs) shall be the cornerstone for planning and implementation of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana. DIPs will identify the gaps in irrigation infrastructure. Preparation of DIPs will be taken up by the District level Implementation Committee (DLIC) as a joint exercise of all participating departments.

4. Funding Pattern

Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana funds will be provided to the State Governments as per the pattern of assistance of Centrally Sponsored Schemes decided by Ministry of Finance and NITI Aayog.

5. Nodal Department

State Agriculture Department will be the Nodal Department for implementation of PMKSY. Nodal Department / agency will also be responsible for monitoring, coordinating physical & financial progress with implementing departments / agencies and furnishing consolidated Utilisation Certificates (UC) and physical / financial progress reports to Government of India.

6. State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC)

The State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC), already constituted under NADP and chaired by the Chief Secretary of the State, will be vested with the authority to sanction specific projects recommended by the Inter Departmental Working Group (IDWG) in a meeting attended by representatives of Government of India.

State Level Sanctioning Committee's (SLSC) shall approve PMKSY projects upto twice the amount of State's annual allocation under PMKSY to cater to multi-year duration projects and prioritizing funding based on physical progress.

Existing State Level Sanctioning Committee shall be strengthened by including members from relevant Departments e.g. Irrigation / water resources and Soil Conservation, Watershed, Rural Development / Rural Works, Forest and State Level Nodal Agency (SLNA) under Integrated Watershed Management Programme.

The SLSC will be supported by the Inter Department Working Group (IDWG), comprising of Secretaries of the line Departments of Horticulture, Agriculture, Rural Development, Irrigation, Surface and Ground Water Resources.

State Nodal Cell / Coordinating Agency will ensure timely receipt of District Irrigation Plans (DIPs), formulation of State Irrigation Plan and its approval by the State Level Sanctioning Committee. The State Nodal Cell will then convey the approval and monitor implementation of the work plans by the line Departments.

7. Inter Departmental Working Group (IDWG):

In the guidelines it has been stated that Inter Department Working Group (IDWG), shall comprise of Secretaries of the line Departments of Agriculture, Horticulture, Rural Development, Water Resources/Irrigation, Command Area Development, Watershed Development, Soil Conservation, Environment & Forest, Departments dealing with Ground Water Resources, drinking water, town planning, industrial policy, science & technology and all concerned departments associated The IDWG will be chaired by the Agricultural Production with water sector. Commissioner / Development Commissioner. Director (Agriculture) / Engineer in Chief (water Resources / Irrigation) will work as co-convenors of IDWG. The IDWG will be responsible for day to day coordination and management of the Scheme activities within the Sate. IDWG will be the coordinating agency among all the ministries / departments/ agencies/ research / financial institutions engaged in creation/ use/ recycling/ conservation of water to bring them together under a single platform to take a comprehensive and holistic view of the entire water cycle so as to ensure that each drop of water is put to the best possible use. It will scrutinize / prioritise the project proposals / DPRs in conformity with the guidelines and that they emanate from SIP/DIPs, besides being consistent with technical standards & financial norms.

8. The District Level Implementation Committee (DLIC)

The DLIC will be chaired by the Collector / Distirct Magistrate and will comprise of CEO Zila Parishad/Project Director, District Rural Development Agency, Joint Director / Deputy Director of Departments of Horticulture, Agriculture, Rural Development, Surface and groundwater resources irrigation and any other line departments in the district, District Forest Officer, Lead bank officer of the District.

The Project Director, Agricultural Technology Management Agency (ATMA) will be the Member Secretary of DLIC. Other Members will be nominated as per guidelines.

The DLIC will oversee the implementation and inter-departmental coordination at district level as per guidelines.

9. Release of funds:

60% of the PMKSY annual allocation will be released as first instalment to the State, upon the receipt of the minutes of SLSC approving implementation of new projects and / or continuation of ongoing projects during the financial year alongwith lists of projects approved. Release of funds will be made by the respective Ministry / Department for the specific component.

10. In view of the above and also in consonance with the Operational Guidelines under PMKSY, the Government direct that the State Agricultural Department shall be the Nodal Department and the Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency will be the Nodal Agency for implementation of the Scheme of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana since Integrated Watershed Management Programme has been merged into PMKSY as per the guidelines. The Government constitute State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) with the following composition and accord approval to implement the PMKSY in the State as per the guidelines issued by Government of India:-
