#### ORDER:

Responding to the demands of various political parties and community organisations, the Hon'ble Chief Minister has announced the constitution of a Commission to collect caste wise quantifiable data as on date. This data would be helpful to better administer and target various welfare schemes of the Government. This quantifiable data would also be necessary to support the policy of 69% reservation followed in the State. The Hon'ble Chief Minister has further announced that the Commission would be headed by Hon'ble Thiru. Justice.A. Kulasekaran, Judge of High Court (Rtd.) and will commence functioning immediately.

- 2. Earlier, the First Backward Classes Commission constituted under the Chairmanship of Thiru A.N. Sattanathan, in the year 1969, extrapolated pre-Independence census data to arrive at the population of various castes in the State.
- 3. Subsequently, in the year 1983, the Tamil Nadu Second Backward Classes Commission (Ambasankar Commission) conducted the caste-wise socio-economic and educational survey by carrying out 100% door-to-door enumeration and submitted its report to Government in 1985. The caste-wise data collected by the Ambasankar Commission is now more than three decades old and there is an urgent need to collect

caste and tribe wise data as on date to render equitable social justice to various classes of citizens in the State.

- 4. To protect the existing 69% reservation in the State, the Tamil Nadu Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Reservation of seats in Educational Institutions and of appointments or posts in the services under the State) Act, 1993 [Tamil Nadu Act 45 of 1994] was enacted and included in the Ninth Schedule of the Constitution of India to get protection under Article 31-B of the Constitution of India. The cases filed before the Supreme Court challenging the 69% reservation are currently pending. The caste and tribe-wise quantifiable data pertaining to various social, educational, economic, and political parameters of various castes and tribes of the State is necessary to support the continuation of 69% reservation.
- 5. The Government after careful consideration hereby constitutes a "Commission for collection of quantifiable data on castes, communities and tribes of Tamil Nadu" to collect data pertaining to various social, educational, economic and political parameters of the population of the State. The Government hereby appoints Hon'ble Thiru. Justice A. Kulasekaran (Rtd.) as Chairman of the Commission. He will be provided with facilities on par with those provided to the Chairman of Tamil Nadu Backward Classes Commission.
  - 6. The terms of reference of the Commission are as follows:-
  - The Commission shall take appropriate steps to identify the number of castes and tribes in the State of Tamil Nadu, including migrants domiciled in Tamil Nadu.
  - II. The Commission shall collect quantifiable data for each of these identified castes and tribes.
  - III. The Commission shall obtain such information as if may consider necessary or relevant for their purpose in such form and manner as they may think appropriate from relevant authorities, organizations or individuals as may in the opinion of the Commission be necessary / or of assistance;
  - IV. The Commission may form sub-committees from amongst its members and hold sittings of the Commission or of such subcommittees at such times and such places as may be determined by or under the authority of the Chairman.
  - V. The Commission will submit its report to the Government within 6 months.
- 7. Orders regarding the appointment of other Members of the Commission will be issued separately. The Director of Most Backward

Classes and Denotified Communities welfare will function as the Member-Secretary of the Commission. The Member Secretary will make all necessary arrangements for the functioning of the Commission including arranging office space, furniture and fittings.

8. The Government also accord sanction for creation of the following posts and also sanction a sum of Rs.67,00,000/-(Rupees sixty seven lakhs only) towards recurring expenditure including salary and Rs.31,00,000/-(Rupees thirty one lakhs) as non-recurring expenditure totalling to Rs.98,00,000/- (Rupees Ninety Eight Lakhs only) towards the constitution of the Commission.

- 10. The Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities will be estimating, reconciling and controlling authority for this new head of account. The Pay and Accounts Officer and Treasury Officer concerned are directed to open the above new Head of Account in their books.
- 11. The expenditure sanctioned in para 8 shall constitute an item of "New Service" and the approval of the Legislature shall be obtained in due course of time by an inclusion in the supplementary estimates for the year 2020-2021. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may initially be met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as an advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Director of Most Backward Classes and Denotified Communities is requested to send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2020-2021 to Finance (BG-I/BC,MBC) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
- 13. The Commission is permitted to undertake visits to various places in the State. It will be treated as a First-Class Committee for the purposes of drawing travelling and other allowances.
