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ORDER :

In the Government order read above, orders were issued sanctioning a sum of Rs. 300/- (Rupees Three hundred only) to the State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, as permanent advance for meeting contingent expenditure of the Commission.

The Registrar, State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission has stated that the said permanent advance has not been enhanced for the past 19 years and due to escalation of prices it is not enough to meet out the contingent expenses. As the State Commission, Chennai has incurred more than Rs. 2000/- per month, the Registrar, State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission has requested the Government to enhance the Permanent Advance from Rs.300/- to Rs.2000/- per month to meet out the day to day contingent expenses to the State Commission, Chennai.

3. The Government after careful consideration, sanction a sum of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two thousand only) to the State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission as permanent advance for meeting day to day contingent expenditure of the Commission.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to "2070 – 00. Other Administrative Services – 800. Other expenditure – I. Non-Plan – BJ. State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission – Head Quarters Staff – 05. Office expenses – 02. Other Contingencies "
