ORDER:

In the reference first read above, the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden for seeking Central Assistance of Rs.38.040 lakhs for taking up certain works under “Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats” - Grizzled Giant Squirrel Wildlife Sanctuary was forwarded to the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests for approval and release of funds as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme during 2012-2013.

2. The Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests in their letter second read above have conveyed their administrative approval for a sum of Rs. 21.350 lakhs and released Rs. 17.08 lakhs as first installment for the “Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats” - Grizzled Giant Squirrel Wildlife Sanctuary, during 2012-2013.

3. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden has also requested the Government to issue orders to release the 1st installment of Rs. 17.08 lakhs entire amount in a single payment under Letter of Credit system instead of releasing in two to three installments throughout year.

4. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden and accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.21.350 lakhs (Rupees Twenty One lakhs Thirth Five thousand only) and release the first installment for a sum of Rs. 17.08 lakhs (Rupees Seventeen lakhs and Eight thousand only) towards the expenditure on the items of works as detailed in the Annexure to this order for the “Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats”- Grizzled Giant Squirrel Wildlife Sanctuary under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme during 2012-2013.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account :-

“4406 Capital Outlay on Forestry and Wildlife 02 Environmental Forestry and Wildlife – 110 Wildlife Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan –III Centrally Sponsored - SH Scheme for Development of Grizzled Squirrel Wildlife Sanctuary - 16 Major Works

(D.P.Code 4406 02 110 SH 1602)”.

6. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden is authorized to incur the expenditure in para - 4 through the Letter of Credit.

7. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden shall ensure that the expenditure in this regard does not exceed the sanction amount and to send the Utilization Certificate to Government of India in time.
