



## **ABSTRACT**

Forests – Wildlife – Scheme for the “Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats” - Vaduvur Birds Sanctuary, Thanjavur District – Administrative Approval for a sum of Rs 10.260 lakhs and release of first Installment of Rs.8.20 lakhs (i.e. Rs. 4.450 lakhs + Rs. 3.750 lakhs of unspent amount of previous year) for 2012-2013 - Orders – Issued.

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### **ORDER:**

In the reference first read above, the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden for seeking Central Assistance of Rs. 24.060 lakhs for taking up certain works under “Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats” - Vaduvur Birds Sanctuary was forwarded to the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests for approval and release of funds as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme during 2012-2013.

2. The Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests in their letter second read above have conveyed their administrative approval for a sum of Rs.10.260 lakhs and released a sum of Rs.8.20 lakhs (i.e. Rs. 4.450 lakhs + Rs. 3.750 lakhs of unspent amount of previous year) as first installment for the “Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats” - Vaduvur Birds Sanctuary during 2012-2013.

3. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden has also requested the Government to issue orders to release the 1st installment of Rs. Rs.8.20 lakhs in a single payment under Letter of Credit system instead of releasing in two to three installments throughout year.

4. The Government after careful consideration accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.10.260 lakhs (Rupees Ten lakhs and Twenty Six thousand only) and release the first installment for a sum of Rs.8.20 lakhs (i.e. Rs. 4.450 lakhs + Rs. 3.750 lakhs of unspent amount of previous year) towards the expenditure on the items of works as detailed in the Annexure to this order for the “Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats” - “Vaduvur Birds Sanctuary under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme during 2012-2013.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account :-

4406 Capital Outlay on Forestry and Wildlife 02 Environmental Forestry and Wildlife - 110 Wildlife Schemes in the Twelfth Five-Year Plan - III Centrally Sponsored SP Scheme for Development of Vaduvloor Bird Sanctuary - 16 Major Works

6. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden is authorized to incur the expenditure in para 4 through Letter of Credit.

7. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden shall ensure that the expenditure in this regard does not exceed the sanction amount and to send the Utilization Certificate to Government of India in time.
