Sub: Forests – Wildlife – TANII - Setting up real time monitoring system to monitor the movement of Elephant herds to strengthen alert mechanism and address Human-Elephant Conflict – Authorization of Rs.2,17,29,000/- – Issued.

Ref: 1. G.O.(D)No.205, Environment, Climate Change and Forests (FR.5) Department, dated 10.10.2023.
2. From the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden letter No.WL6/ 8951/2023, dated 20.05.2024.

In the circumstances stated in the letter second cited, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Department) is authorized to incur the expenditure of Rs.2,17,29,000/- (Rupees two crore Seventeen lakhs and Twenty Nine thousand only) for the year 2024-2025 for "Setting up real time monitoring system to monitor the movement of Elephant herds to strengthen alert mechanism and address Human-Elephant Conflict", which was originally sanctioned in Government order first cited under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) Schemes for the year 2023-2024.

2. The amount sanctioned in para-1 above shall be debited into the following Head of Account:-

"2406 Forestry and Wild life – 02 Environmental Forestry and Wild life – 110 Wild Life Preservation – State's Expenditure – BA Setting up of real time monitoring system to monitor the movement of Elephant and herds to strengthen alert mechanism and address Human – Elephant Conflict under State Innovation Fund – 309 Grants-in-Aid – 03 Grants for Specific Scheme".
(IFHRMS DPC : 2406 02 110 BA 30903) – Rs.2,17,29,000/-

The above expenditure shall be adjusted by deducting under the following head of account:-

“2406 Forestry and Wild life – 02 Environmental Forestry and Wild life – 902 Deduct – amount met from Reserve Fund – State’s Expenditure – JA – Amount met from State Innovation Fund – 330 Inter Account Transfer – 01 Inter Account Transfer”.

Contra debiting the following Account:

“J Reserve Fund – (b) Reserve funds not bearing interest – 8229 – 00 – Development and Welfare Funds – 200 – Other Development and Welfare Funds – BE State Innovation Fund – 802 Outgo – 02 Not bearing interest.”

3. Necessary additional funds of Rs.2,17,29,000/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2024-2025. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Chennai-32 is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para-1 above. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislative Assembly by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2024-2025. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Chennai-32 is directed to include this item of expenditure while sending the Budget proposal for RE/FMA 2024-2025 and also to send draft explanatory note for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2024-2025 to Government in Finance (E,CC&F/BG-I) Department, without fail.

4. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.643/E.CC&F/2024, dated 21.06.2024 and Additional Sanction ledger No.0283 (Two Hundred and Eighty Three) (IFHRMS ASL No.2024060283)
