<u>APPENDIX.</u> <u>NOTIFICATION – I.</u>

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Forest Act, 1882 (Tamil Nadu Act V of 1882), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby declares that it is proposed to constitute the land within the boundaries specified in the Schedule below as reserved forest and appoints the Special Tahsildar (Forest Settlement), Dindigul ex-officio, to be the Forest Settlement Officer to exercise the powers under clause (c) of the said section in respect of that area.

THE SCHEDULE.

BOUNDARIES.

North.- The boundary starts from the tri-junction point of Survey Numbers 821, 543/1 of No.26, Virupatchi village and No.90, Dhasaripatti Village (at Survey station No.A) and generally runs towards east along the southern boundary of Survey Numbers 821 and 829 of No.26, Virupatchi village and thence generally runs towards west, south, east, south, east, south and east along the western and southern boundary of Survey Numbers 543/24 of No.26, Virupatchi village. Thence the boundary runs towards south along the western boundary of Survey Numbers 543/29 of No.26, Virupatchi village and thence the boundary runs towards west, south, east, north and west along the northern, western, southern, eastern and northern boundary of Survey Numbers 543/30 of No.26, Virupatchi village. Thence it generally runs towards north along the eastern boundary of Survey Numbers 543/29 of No.26, Virupatchi village. Thence the boundary generally runs towards northeast and east along the southern boundary of Survey Numbers 543/24, 530, 531,532, 533, 534, 535 and 536 of No.26, Virupatchi village and reaches the tri-junction point of Survey Numbers 536, 539 and 543/1 of No.26, Virupatchi village.

<u>East.-</u> Thence, the boundary generally runs towards southeast, east and south along the western and southern boundary of Survey Numbers 543/2, 573 and 572 of No.26, Virupatchi village and thence it generally runs towards west and south along the northern and western boundary of Survey Numbers 543/31 of No.26, Virupatchi village and reaches the tri-junction point of Survey Numbers 543/1, 543/31 and 543/3 of No.26, Virupatchi village.

<u>South</u>.- Thence, the boundary generally runs towards west along the northern boundary of Survey Numbers 543/3, 546, 545 and 544 of No.26, Virupatchi village and reaches the tri-junction point of Survey Numbers 543/1, 544 of No.26, Virupatchi village and No.90, Dhasaripatti Village (at Survey station No.E).

<u>West.</u>- Thence the boundary generally runs towards northwest and north along the northeastern and northern common village boundary of No.90, Dhasaripatti Village and No.26, Virupatchi village and reaches the starting point.

NOTIFICATION - II.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the last paragraph of section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Forest Act, 1882 (Tamil Nadu Act V of 1882), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby appoints the District Forest Officer, Dindigul, ex-officio, to attend on behalf of the Government at the inquiry prescribed under Chapter-II of the said Act, in respect of the land of Virupatchi Forest Block proposed to be constituted as reserved forest.

NOTIFICATION - III.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the section 14 of the Tamil Nadu Forest Act, 1882 (Tamil Nadu Act V of 1882), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby appoints the Personal Assistant (General) to the Collector of Dindigul District, Dindigul ex-officio to hear the appeals, if any, against the orders passed under sections 11, 12 and 13 of the said Act, in respect of the land of Virupatchi Forest Block proposed to be constituted as reserved forest.
