Bit-I Survey Number – 79 – Area 43.28.5 hectare

<u>North.</u>- The boundary line starting from the Junction Point of North West Corner of Survey Number 79 of No.38 Kappalur Village and Survey Number 187 of No.35 Siruganur Village, the boundary runs generally towards East along the Southern side of Survey Number 187 of No.35 Siruganur Village and reaches the tri-junction point of Survey Number 187 of No.35 Siruganur Village, Survey Number 79 and 81 of No.38 Kappalur Village.

<u>East.</u>- Thence, the boundary runs towards South along the Western side of Survey Numbers 81 and 80 of No.38, Kappalur Village and reaches the tri-junction point of Survey Numbers 81, 74, 79 of No.38 Kappalur Village.

<u>South.-</u> Thence, the boundary runs towards West along the Northern side of Survey Number 74, East and Northern side of Survey Number 76 and Northern Side of Survey Number 78 of No.38 Kappalur Village and reaches the tri-junction point

of Survey Numbers 78 and 79 of No.38 Kappalur Village and Survey Number 187 of No.35 Siruganur Village Boundary.

<u>West.-</u> Thence, the boundary runs generally towards North along the Eastern side of Survey Number 187 of No.35 Siruganur Village and reaches the Starting Point.

Right is admitted to the Public to use of the Kannakudi to Devakottai Motorable Road, which is starting from the Cutting Measurement of 77.2 Meters from south east boundary of Survey Number 157 of No.38 Kappalur Village and runs towards West and Southwest and reaches one of the block at the Cutting Measurement of 36.0 Meter from Southwest side of this Forest Block. Permission is allowed to Rural Development Department and Highway to carry out Maintenance
