ANNEXURE

The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Hon'ble Governor on the 9 th April 2020 and is hereby published for general information:

Act No.16 of 2020

An Act to provide for the appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2020.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventy-first Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (No. 3) Act, 2020.

Short title

Tamil Nadu Act 15 of 2020. 2. The State Government may appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2020, a sum not exceeding Three lakh four thousand nine hundred fifty four crore forty three lakh and fifty thousand rupees, which shall be inclusive of the sum of One lakh ninety five thousand three hudred forty two crore thirty two lakh and ninety four thousand rupees specified in section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2020 being moneys required to meet-

Appropriation out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2020.

- (a) the grants made by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for the year, as set forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and
- (b) the expenditure *charged* on the Consolidated Fund of the State for that year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.
