### **ORDER:**

In the Government Order first read above, Government has constituted an Accreditation Committee consisting of the Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts as Head of the Committee, the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services and a representative of the United India Insurance Company Limited as Members of the Committee for empanelment of accredited hospitals and to also monitor the quality of treatment for the Employees of Government Department and Other organisations covered under New Health Insurance Scheme. Based on the report of the Accreditation Committee with its specific recommendation for accreditation of hospitals, the Government have empanelled 913 private hospitals for effective implementation of the New Health Insurance Scheme for both employees and pensioners.

**2.** In the Government Order second and third read above, orders have been issued for the implementation of New Health Insurance Scheme to provide Health Care Assistance to the employees of Government Departments, Public Sector Undertakings, Statutory Boards, Local Bodies, State Government Universities, willing State Government Organisations/ Institutions and their eligible family members, Pensioners (including spouse) / Family Pensioners.

**3.** The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts in his letter fourth read above has sent his proposal to the Government to issue detailed guidelines for the empanelment of private hospitals under New Health Insurance Scheme (Employees and Pensioners).

4. After careful consideration, the Government decided to issue detailed guidelines for empanelment of private hospitals for treatment / surgeries on CASHLESS basis under New Health Insurance Scheme for employees and pensioners as follows:

(1) The Accreditation Committee shall consist of the following officials:-

(a)	Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts.	Head
(b)	Director of Medical and Rural Health Services or his nominee.	Member
(c)	Representative of the Public Sector Health Insurance Company / Third Party Administrator under the control of the Public Sector Health Insurance Company.	Member

(2) The Accreditation Committee shall examine the standards of the hospitals to be empanelled and to monitor the quality of the treatment provided for the beneficiaries covered under New Health Insurance Scheme.

(3) The following Sub-Committees shall be constituted at district level to assist the Accreditation Committee for empanelment of private hospitals under the Scheme.

**(a) Sub-Committee in Chennai District consists of the following officials:**

- (i) Joint Director of Treasuries and Accounts.
- (ii) Joint Director of Medical and Rural Health Services of the concerned District
- (iii) Representative of the Public Sector Health Insurance Company / Third Party Administrator under the control of the Public Sector Health Insurance Company.

**(b) Sub-Committee in Districts other than Chennai consists of the following officials:**

- (i) District Treasury Officer.
- (ii) Joint Director of Health Services of the concerned District.
- (iii) Representative of the Public Sector Health Insurance Company / Third Party Administrator approved by the Insurance Company in each District.

(4) The Accreditation Committee shall invite application from the private hospitals for empanelment under New Health Insurance Scheme to treatments and surgeries on CASHLESS basis.

(5) The private hospitals willing to get empanelled under the scheme at the package rates offered by the Insurance Company to similarly placed Hospital, shall apply to the Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts who is the administrator of the scheme in the format prescribed in the Annexure-I in triplicate. It is clarified that package rates are mutually agreed between the Insurance Company and the Hospital empanelled through a contract and the Government does not play any role in the finalisation of the package rate.

(6) On receipt of the application from the private hospital, the Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts shall send the application of the hospitals to the Sub-Committees concerned for consideration of the hospitals for empanelment under the scheme, after due inspection.

(7) On receipt of the application from the Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts, the Sub-Committee shall inspect all the private hospitals to be empanelled under the scheme in their District in the State of Tamil Nadu and in the adjacent district outside the State and submit the inspection report as per the format prescribed in Annexure-II for Single Speciality hospitals and as per the format prescribed in Annexure-III for Multi Speciality hospitals to the Accreditation Committee within a period of three months from the date of receipt of application.

(8) The Accreditation Committee after detailed examination of the standards of the hospitals shall submit the report to the Government within a period of three months with specific recommendations for accreditation of hospitals in Chennai and other Districts for the empanelment of the hospitals under the New Health Insurance Scheme.

(9) In case of hospitals not willing to continue, the Accreditation Committee shall examine and send the report to the Government for deletion of such hospitals under the scheme.

(10) For inclusion of additional specialties available for treatments / surgeries and deletion of treatments / surgeries if any under New Health Insurance Scheme, such inclusions/ deletions shall be added / deleted in the existing list from time to time based on the report of the Accreditation Committee.

(11) Any complaint / grievance against the accredited hospital under the scheme with reference to standards mentioned in the Annexure or of any serious violation of conditions of the New Health Insurance Scheme shall be addressed to the Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts.

(12) The Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts, as the head of the Accreditation Committee, shall send the complaint to the Sub-committee concerned for investigation. On receipt of the complaint from the Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts, the Sub-Committee shall inspect the concerned Hospital and submit the investigation report to the Accreditation Committee for further action, within a period of one month after the receipt of the complaint.

(13) The Accreditation Committee shall examine the investigation report of the Sub-committee and recommend further necessary action to the Government within a period of one month after giving due notice

to the empanelled hospital. Based on this final report of the Accreditation Committee, the Government may withdraw the accreditation and delete the Hospital from the empanelled list under the New Health Insurance Scheme.

**Annexure I**

Standards of the hospitals to be followed for empanelment under New Health

Insurance Scheme:

- i) The hospitals under the Scheme would include:
  - A) Pay wards of Government Hospitals
  - B) Private Hospitals
- ii) A private hospitals shall be qualified and tied up as a networked hospital by the insurance company only if it complies with the minimum criteria as under:
  - A) It should have at least 15 inpatient beds in respect of Class A city and Class B city and 10 inpatient beds in respect of Class C city as per the classification of cities by the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority.
  - B) It should be equipped and engaged in providing medical and surgical facilities along with diagnostic facilities i.e Pathological tests, X-ray and other investigations like Electro Cardio Graph etc., for the care and treatment of injured or sick persons as inpatients.
  - C) It should have a fully equipped Operation Theatre of its own wherever surgical operations are carried out.
  - D) It should have fully equipped nursing staff under its employment round the clock.
  - E) It should maintain complete records as required on day to day basis and be able to provide necessary records of the insured patient to the Insurer or his representative as and when required.
  - F) It should have functioned as an inpatient facility for a minimum period of one year.
- iii) All the 913 hospitals accredited under the New Health Insurance Scheme shall be deemed to be networked hospitals and the Insurance Company shall ensure that they have a tie-up with these hospitals before the commencement of the Scheme.
- iv) At least three institutions (excluding Government Hospitals) each situated at Puducherry, Bengaluru, Thiruvananthapuram and New Delhi shall also be covered.

- v) The Insurance Company shall ensure the availability of a minimum of 6 networked hospitals in each district of the State and the availability of a minimum 50 networked hospitals excluding Government hospitals in the areas under each district cluster as indicated below:

**A) Northern Cluster:**

Chennai, Tiruvallur, Kancheepuram, Vellore, Tiruvannamalai, Villupuram and Cuddalore.

**B) Central Cluster:**

Perambalur, Ariyalur, Nagapattinam, Tiruvarur, Tiruchirapalli, Thanjavur, Pudukottai and Karur.

**C) Western Cluster:**

Krishnagiri, Dharmapuri, Salem, Erode, Namakkal, Nilgris, Coimbatore and Tiruppur.

**D) Southern Cluster:**

Madurai, Theni, Sivagangai, Virudhunagar, Dindigul, Ramanathapuram, Tirunelveli, Kanyakumari and Thoothukudi.

If any district or cluster does not have the number of hospitals as specified above the successful Insurance Company can seek specific exemption for that district or cluster and the same will be considered by the Government of Tamil Nadu after verification of the available qualified hospitals in that district or cluster.
