I am to invite your attention to the references cited.

- **2.** In the Government letter first cited, it was directed to extend the orders of Dearness Allowance issued for employees who are in pre-2016 pay scales for grant Dearness Allowance at the rate from 164% to 196% with effect from 01.01.2022 to the Pensioners and Family Pensioners also who are drawing pre-revised Pension and Family Pension.
- **3.** In the Office Memorandum second cited, the Government of India has revised the rate of Dearness Allowance from 196% to 203% of the Basic Pay with effect from 01-01-2022 to the employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised Pay Scale/Grade Pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission.

- **4.** In the reference third cited, among others, orders have been issued, revising the rate of Dearness Allowance to the State Government employees drawing pay in the pre-2016 pay scales from 196% to 203% with effect from 01-07-2022.
- **5.** I am therefore to request you to extend the orders of Dearness Allowance issued in respect of the employees who are drawing pay in pre-2016 pay scales enhancing the rate of Dearness Allowance from **196% to 203%** with effect from 01-07-2022 to the Pensioners and Family Pensioners also who are drawing pre-revised pension and family pension.
- **6.** I am also to request you to draw the arrears of Dearness Allowance for the month of July 2022 at the rate ordered in para-5 above and make payment to the Pensioners and Family Pensioners also who are drawing pre-revised pension and family pension immediately.
