In the reference fifth cited, Tamil Nadu Rural Development & Panchayat Raj Department All Pensioner's Association has requested to clarify whether the Personal Pay of Rs.1000/-p.m. sanctioned to the employees in the post of Block Development Officer's / Tahsildars who were working in the period of 01.02.2011 to 31.12.2015 can be taken into account for calculation of annual increment and pensionary benefits.
- 3. I am to clarify that the Personal Pay of Rs.1000/-p.m. sanctioned in the Government Order third cited is eligible for taking into calculation of annual increment and pensionary benefits to the employees who were working/retired in the

post of Block Development Officer's / Tahsildars / Inspector of Police / Forest Ranger during the period from 01.02.2011 to 31.12.2015.

4. Further I am to clarify that the standalone Personal Pay Rs.2600/-p.m. sanctioned w.e.f.01.01.2016 is not eligible for computing annual increment and pensionary benefit to the employees working / retired during the period from 01.01.2016 in the Tamil Nadu Revised Pay Rules 2017.
