Higher Education - Annamalai University – Rajah Muthiah Institute of Health Sciences – Surrender of 50% of seats in Post Graduate Degree and Post Graduate Diploma seats in Medicine and Post Graduate Degree seats in Dentistry to All India Quota and filling up of 50% of seats in Post Graduate Degree and Post Graduate Diploma Programmes in Medicine and Post Graduate Degree seats in Dentistry through the Selection Committee, Office of the Director of Medical Education for the year 2020-21 – Orders – Issued.

### ORDER:

During the year 2013-14, the Annamalai University had conducted entrance examinations for the P.G courses and filled up 103 seats out of 135 in Medicine and 22 seats out of 37 in Dentistry. In respect of the remaining seats, the Government, in the Government Order first read above, had issued orders directing the Secretary, Selection Committee, Office of the Director of Medical Education to fillup the seats in P.G.Degree and Diploma Programmes in Medicine and Dentistry in Rajah Muthiah Institute of Health Sciences in Annamalai University through the Selection Committee, Office of the Director of Medical Education, Chennai for the year 2013-14.

2. In the Government Orders second to seventh read above, the Government had issued orders directing the Secretary, Selection Committee, Office of the Director of Medical Education to fillup the seats in P.G.Degree and Diploma Programmes in Medicine and Dentistry in Rajah Muthiah Institute of Health Sciences in Annamalai University through the Selection Committee, Office of the Director of Medical Education, Chennai for the years 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20, by following the rule of reservation as prescribed by the Government.

3. In the letter eighth read above, the Registrar (i/c), Annamalai University has stated that the Annamalai University Act 1928 has been repealed and replaced with Annamalai University Act 2013 (Act 20 of 2013) and subsequently the status of Rajah Muthiah Medical College, Annamalai University has changed from "Trust" to "Government" by the Medical Council of India. The Government of Tamil Nadu has also endorsed the Rajah Muthiah Medical College as Government Medical College (under Self-finance mode). The University is conducting both UG & PG Degree courses in Medicine and Dentistry. From the Academic year 2014 – 15 onwards all the PG seats of Rajah Muthiah Medical College & Rajah Muthiah Dental College were filled by the Selection Committee, Directorate of Medical Education, Government of Tamil Nadu.

4. The Registrar (i/c), Annamalai University has further stated that from the Academic year 2018 – 19, the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India vide letter dated 21.06.2017, has also instructed Rajah Muthiah Medical College & Rajah Muthiah Dental College to surrender 50 % of Postgraduate seats to DGHS to be included in the All India Quota. The remaining 50 % seats are to be surrendered to the State Government to be filled by the Common Counselling conducted by Selection Committee, Directorate of Medical Education, Chennai, Government of Tamil Nadu.

5. The Registrar (i/c), Annamalai University has therefore requested the Government to issue orders for the surrender of 50% of Post Graduate Degree seats in Medicine (59 seats out of 111 in MD / MS), Post Graduate Diploma seats in Medicine (12 seats out of 18 in Diploma) and 50% of Post Graduate Degree seats in Dentistry (10 seats out of 20 in MDS) to All India Quota for the Academic year 2020 – 21 and also send a communication to the Department of Health & Family Welfare to notify, include & display the remaining 50% seats in Post Graduate Degree in Medicine ( 52 seats in MD/MS out of 111), Post Graduate Diploma in Medicine (6 seats of 18 in Diploma) and Post Graduate Degree in Dentistry ( 10 seats in MDS out of 20 ) in Dentistry during the Common Counselling which will be held by the Selection Committee, Directorate of Medical Education, Chennai for the ensuing academic year 2020-21.

6. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar (i/c), Annamalai University direct the Registrar (i/c), Annamalai University to surrender 50% of Post Graduate Degree seats in Medicine (59 seats out of 111 in

MD / MS), Post Graduate Diploma seats in Medicine (12 seats out of 18 in Diploma) and 50% of Post Graduate Degree seats in Dentistry (10 seats out of 20 in MDS) to All India Quota and also direct the Secretary, Selection Committee, Office of the Director of the Medical Education to fill up the remaining 50% seats in Post Graduate Degree seats in Medicine (52 seats in MD/MS out of 111), Post Graduate Diploma seats in Medicine (6 seats of 18 in Diploma) and Post Graduate Degree seats in Dentistry ( 10 seats in MDS out of 20 ) in Rajah Muthiah Institute of Health Sciences in Annamalai University through the Selection Committee, Directorate of Medical Education for the academic year 2020-21. The details of seats and guidelines are annexed (Annexure I & II) to this order.

7. The Secretary, Selection Committee, Office of the Director of Medical Education is also directed to follow the rule of reservation as prescribed by the Government.
