ORDER :

During the Budget Speech 2019-20, the Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister among other Announcements, has made an Announcement that a sum of Rs.100 crore will be sanctioned to upgrade infrastructure, including equipment, to impart teaching at international standards in the Anna University and the Engineering Colleges under the control of the Directorate of Technical Education.

2. Considering the welfare of the poor rural students studying in Government Engineering Colleges from socio-economic background, in the letter second read above, the Director of Technical Education has sent the proposal to accord Administrative and Financial sanction for a sum of Rs.60.00 crores for upgradation of infrastructure facilities in the Government Engineering Colleges at Theni, Thanjavur, Dharmapuri, Trichy, Tirunelveli, Krishnagiri, Sivagangai, Vellore, Salem and Coimbatore along with the details of equipments required, cost of equipments, total cost involved along with justification for the procurement of the equipment. He has further stated that, in order to enhance the teaching learning process, internal revenue generation, employability skills of the students, technical skilled manpower, research facilities, fulfilment of the academic requirements as per revised All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) norms and affiliating University and also to modernize the laboratories to cater to the requirements of the global standards, it is felt very much essential to upgrade the infrastructure facilities and enhance the research activities in Government Engineering Colleges in Tamil Nadu.

3. In the letter third read above, the Vice-Chancellor, Anna University, has sent a proposal for administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.100.00 crore so as to make Hostel facilities in the Regional Campus, and University Colleges of Engineering and provision of Lab equipments in the constituent colleges.

4. The Government after careful examination of the proposals of the Director of Technical Education and the Vice-Chancellor, Anna University decided to sanction a sum of Rs.60,00,00,000/- (Rupees Sixty crore only) to the Directorate of Technical Education for upgradation of infrastructure facilities and enhancement of research facilities in the 10 Government Engineering Colleges at Theni, Thanjavur, Dharmapuri, Trichy, Tirunelveli, Krishnagiri, Sivagangai, Vellore, Salem and Coimbatore under the control of Directorate of Technical Education and also to sanction a sum of Rs.40,00,00,000/- (Rupees Forty crore only) to the Anna University towards purchase of Equipments in 16 Constituent Colleges and Construction of Boys, Girls Hostel in University College of Engineering, Dindigul and Girls Hostel in Regional Campus, Madurai as mentioned in the Annexure I and II.

6. The expenditure of Rs.60.00 crore sanctioned in para 4 above, constitutes an item of "New Instrument of Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Director of Technical Education is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Director of Technical Education is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2019-20 to Finance (BG-I/Edn-I) Department at an appropriate time.

7. The Director of Technical Education is authorized to draw the expenditure of Rs.40.00 crore sanctioned in para 4 above from the provision made in BE 2019-20 and disburse the same to the Anna University.
